

This inspection and survey were conducted on March 17, 1998 by Jonathan C. Spero C.W.R.E. # 123 together with Steven McMahan.

The SOURCE of water is the East Fork of the Illinois River as per the Transfer Order.

The USE of water is IRRIGATION as per the Transfer Order.

The PLACE OF USE is T.40 S. R.08 W. W.M. Section 2 SE 1/4, NW 1/4 11.6 acres and NE 1/4, NW 1/4 20.0 acres as per the Transfer Order. This is

Applicants have completed the Transfer (Change in Point of Diversion), have complied with the conditions stated in the Transfer Order, have done so within the time limits stated on the Transfer Order.

The project was completed as per the Application Map and the Transfer Order. In the accompanying Final Proof Survey the diversion structure as constructed was tied by measurement to the Center - West 1/16th corner for Section 2 rather than the North 1/4 corner (as shown on the Application Map and stated on the Transfer Order) as this survey monument is closer to the new diversion.

Page 2 SALEM OREGON

SOURCE: The East Fork of the Illinois River. This is the primary source of supply.

DIVERSION POINT: This Claim is to document the new Point of Diversion. The new Diversion structure is an Infiltration Gallery along the edge of the East Fork of the Illinois River. The structure consists of a 36" diameter galvanized corrugated metal pipe, 13 feet long, placed vertically, and extending roughly 2 feet above ordinary high water. Under this is a 10" diameter lateral infiltration pipe, 40 feet long (per the owner). From the infiltration lateral, a 5" diameter suction pipe extends 17' vertically and then 19' horizontally to the pump and motor.

MOTOR: BALDOR brand, 15 horse power, 230 volt, 36 amp, 60 hz, 3 phase electric motor with 3450 max R.P.M.'s.

PUMP: PACO brand, Type "L", centrifugal pump with 2" intake and 2" discharge.

PIPE:

Buried, PVC Pipe:

4" diameter mainline 2020 feet 1 1/2" diameter pipe 320 feet 1 1/4" diameter pipe 1060 feet 1" diameter pipe 1280 feet 3/4" diameter pipe 1720 feet

Buried, 1" diameter black poly pipe: 1000 feet +/-

The 4" mainline has 3" diameter risers at 120 foot spacings. Above Ground Hand Line aluminum pipe:

- 7, 3" diameter X 40' long
- 2, 3" diameter X 20' long
- 60. 3" diameter X 30' long

HEADS:

The system uses the following sprinkler heads:

- 70, RAINBIRD Model 30 sprinklers with 5/32" nozzles The maximum number normally used at once is 51 of these. Per the owner, these run at about 50 PSI and disperse about 5 G.P.M. each.
- 105, RAINBIRD steel head sprinklers with 7/64" square nozzles. All of these are normally used at once. Per the owner, these run at about 55 PSI and disperse about 2.6 G.P.M each.

HEADS, (continued from preceding page):

26, LEGO brand sprinkler heads with 1/8" diameter nozzles. Per the owner, these run at about 50 PSI and disperse about 3.2 G.P.M. each. These are normally all run at once and sometimes run in conjunction with the other sprinklers described above.

As irrigation season has not yet begun, no actual test was made of operating pressure during this inspection.

USE: IRRIGATION

The South field is planted in blueberries.

The Middle field was used in 1997 as a commercial truck garden. Crops included watermelon, cantaloupe, corn, tomatoes, garlic, artichokes and squash.

The East edge of the large, North field is currently in a cover crop. The owner plans to plant asparagus in 1998.

The remainder of the North field is planted in Alfalfa for hay. The small fields in the Northeast corner are used for cattle pasture.

LIFT:

On the date of this inspection, the water level in the vertical pipe was about 1.5 feet below the top of the pipe. The fields range in elevation from about 5 feet above, to about 4 feet below the top of the pipe. The mean elevation of the field is about level with the top of the pipe.

SURVEY TIE:

The new Point of Diversion was tied by measurements made during this inspection to the Center - West 1/16th corner for Section 2 (T.40 S. R.08 W. W.M.) which corner is monumented with a 5/8" diameter iron rod and bearing trees per Survey # 147-68 (Josephine County Surveyor's records).

No SPECIAL CONDITIONS, related to this inspection, are listed on the Transfer Order.

REMARKS: The Owner - and Permittee, Steven McMahan, has completed the Transfer (Change in Point of Diversion) and is irrigating the land shown on the accompanying Final Proof Survey Map for beneficial use.

We have determined, after reviewing the design of the new diversion intakes with our groundwater section, that these transfers are of a surface water to surface water type and therefore are not required to have a licensed geologist report.

The new diversion intakes under the stream bed will be considered as being part of the design of a surface diversion as long as they are buried in a graded gravel envelope which is in direct contact with surface water.

You should also be aware that there will be a provision in the Final Order/Certificates stating that if the stream goes dry immediately upstream from these new intakes, they will be considered as taking groundwater and will be turned off.

- II. The land involved is located in Josephine County, Oregon, Tax Lot No. 1400, Section 2, Township 40S, Range 08 West, Willamette Meridian.
- III. It is mutually agreed that development of the project shall be shared as follows:

A. COOPERATORS will:

- Provide project design and review assistance;
- Pay electric costs for pumping water;
- 3. Pay costs of project maintenance;
- 4. Provide logs with root wads attached and transportation to project site;
- Provide equipment and labor to trench and bury approximately 850' of electrical wire;
- Provide labor for installation of pump and appurtenances, including concrete slab and miscellaneous equipment as necessary.

B. COUNCIL will:

- 1. Provide funding for:
 - a. Infiltration gallery supplies & materials;
 - b. Stand pipe, pump & appurtenances;
 - c. Electrical installation (materials & labor);
 - d. Equipment and operators;
 - e. Boulders, root wads and other stabilization materials and transportation;
 - f. Plant materials and labor;
 - g. Miscellaneous supplies such as, rebar, glue, cable, augers, twine and labor;

- h. Project professional and technical assistance, and administration;
- i. Monitoring for five (5) years after project completion.

B. DISTRICT will:

- 1. Provide and/or secure the services of professional and technical serves as needed;
- 2. Provide services to secure and administer project contracts;
- Provide services to secure materials and supplies;
- 4. Provide personnel for project labor through other grant programs
- 5. Set-up and provide monitoring services for a period of five (5) years after project completion.
- IV. It is mutually agreed that supervision, management and maintenance of the project shall be as follows:

A. COOPERATORS will:

- 1. Permit DISTRICT, COUNCIL, or their authorized agents to enter onto the COOPERATOR'S land for the purposes of: implementing the project; examining the condition of structures; repairing as necessary; monitoring activities; demonstrating project results to landowners, engineers and other parties who are have an interest in designing and implementing similar projects. The DISTRICT, COUNCIL, or their authorized agents shall schedule all such visits with the COOPERATORS prior to entering their land;
- Maintain improvements for a minimum of five years provided funding is available;
- 3. Allow placement of Watershed Health signs at the project site.

B. DISTRICT and COUNCIL will:

- Implement project in coordination with COOPERATORS;
- 2. Repair or replace damages to structures resulting from flood or other natural causes provided restoration funding is available.
- 3. Provide vegetative material and seed, including labor, in areas with less than 50% survival provided funding is available.
- V. DISTRICT, COUNCIL or their authorized agents will not be held liable for any damages, accidental harm or death of COOPERATORS, their employees or representatives.
- VI. COOPERATORS or their authorized agents will not be held liable for any damages, accidental harm or death of DISTRICT'S or COUNCIL'S employees or representatives.
- VII. It is further agreed that after completion of the project, improvement will become the property of the COOPERATORS.
- VIII. This AGREEMENT shall remain in full force and effect for the duration of five (5) years, unless terminated by mutual consent of the parties or is terminated by either party after due notice, in writing, because of violation of any terms of this agreement.

IX. The estimated time of completion of this project shall be September, 1996.
