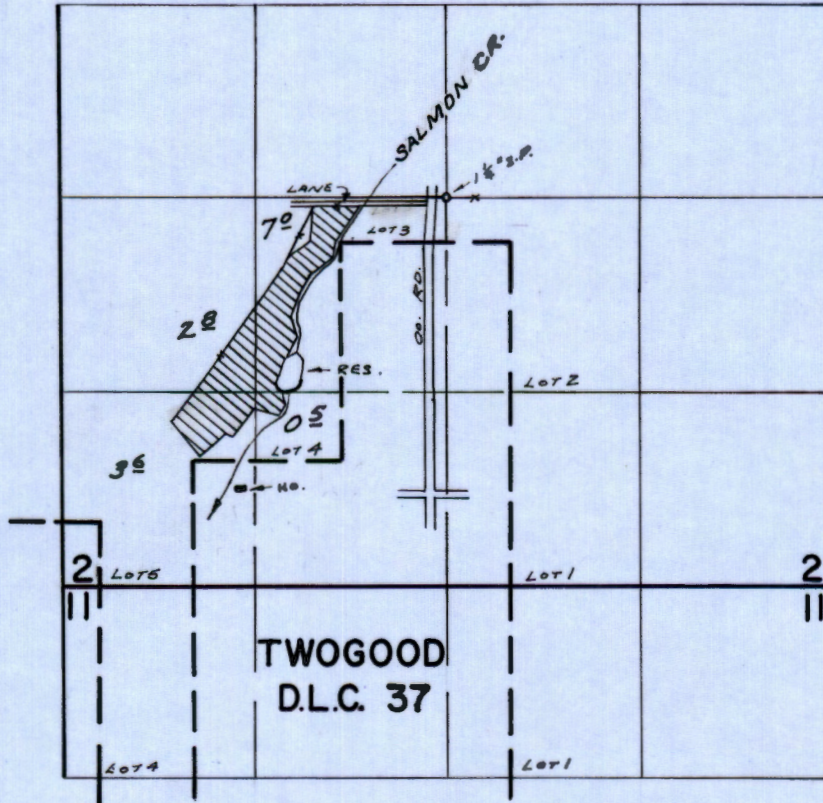

a tributary of Grave Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 4.1 acres and supplemental irrigation of 9.8 acres
under Permit No. 31188 of the State Engineer, and that the use of said waters has been
completed under the terms of said permit; that the priority of the
right dates from February 10, 1966

that the amount of water for the purposes aforesaid, has been actually beneficially used in the
amount of
0.17 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 2, T. 34 S., R. 6 W.,
W. M.; 1070 feet West and 1320 feet South from center, Section 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be
further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each
acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and
storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-4702, provided further
that the right allowed herein shall be limited to the use of stored water only
on land described as supplemental

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

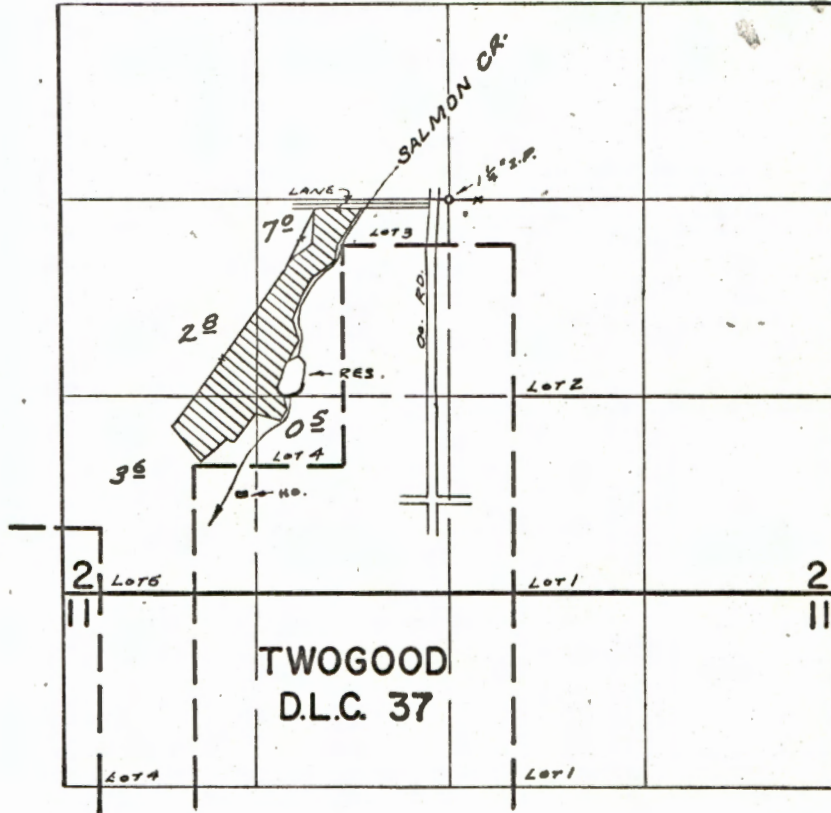



Dear Mr. Angeli:

According to your letter of March 20, 1972, and the enclosed map. There is additional acreage on the South and West ends of the irrigated fields as surveyed by our engineers.

You also mentioned that you clean your reservoir of silt and gravel deposits each year.

If our information is correct, another survey of your irrigation project under permits R-4702 and 31188 would be needed.

I am planning to have a field crew in your area from April 10 to April 21 of this year. Another survey will be made at that time, and will include only that part of the project completed on or before October 1, 1969, as defined by the terms of permit 31188.

The final proof forms mailed to you on February 11, 1972, can be returned to this office unsigned. New proof will be prepared for your inspection and approval after the new survey is made.

In the meantime, the permits which you hold will be valid evidence of the water rights in question as long as you continue to use the water.

also in regard to the amount of water that is being stored in my reservoir, since the state built F 5 just north of my property there has been a large amount of sand + gravel washed into it every year + I have to get it cleared out with a drag line, your survey crew apparently got here before the drag-line crew, I couldn't possibly get full coverage with just a 3.5 reservoir. It's bad enough it dries up every year in July

I can't see any reason at all
to just let the water flow out
to the ocean, when I can be making
very good use of it.

Your cooperation on this matter

This will acknowledge your letter dated March 2, 1972, in connection with permits numbered R-4702 and 31188.

The permits did describe the irrigation of 25.5 acres and the storage of 6.55 acre feet of water from Salmon Creek and Reservoir, but a right can only be perfected to the extent water is actually used. Our field engineer surveyed the area that you claimed irrigated and he found a total of 11.7 acres irrigated, and the survey of the reservoir indicated 3.5 acre feet of stored water. The acreage claimed as irrigated is shown on the enclosed copy of the final proof survey map. The proof of appropriation of water is intended to describe only the actual use of water as found by the engineer and defines the extent to which your water right has been completed within the terms of your permit. Your letter does not indicate where the additional lands are being irrigated. Would you please indicate on the enclosed map your location of these additional lands. Would you please also let us know what you figure the computations are that you are basing your claim for more stored water in the reservoir than has been allowed by our final proof survey.

If after further inspection you believe our survey is correct, then the proofs of appropriation of water should be signed by both of you and returned to this office along with the certificate recording fees of \$3.00.

I am not sure that the application for extension of time you submitted is required as it does not contain very much information. This will acknowledge the return of Reservoir Application No. 41675, a small dam data sheet and a map. Also acknowledged is the receipt of your application for a permit to appropriate 0.32 cubic foot per second of water from Salmon Creek for the irrigation of 25.5 acres, a map and fees of \$15.00 for which our receipt number 8500 is enclosed.

This application has been filed and numbered 41867 and is in satisfactory form for approval by issuance of a permit, as soon as the reservoir application is approved.

The spillway for the reservoir as described in the reservoir application, is too small for the projected floods to meet the minimum safety standards of the State Engineer. You must have a spillway that is 16 feet wide on the bottom, 28 feet wide on the top, with a depth of 3 feet, or any other combination that will pass 250 cubic feet per second before we can approve this application.

The reservoir application must be signed on the space provided immediately following Item No. 13.

I am returning your application and dam data sheet for correction. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its date of priority it must be returned to this office on or before April 15, 1966.

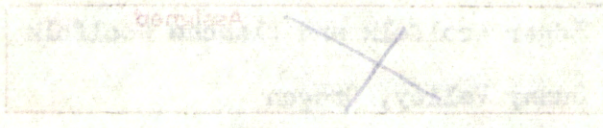

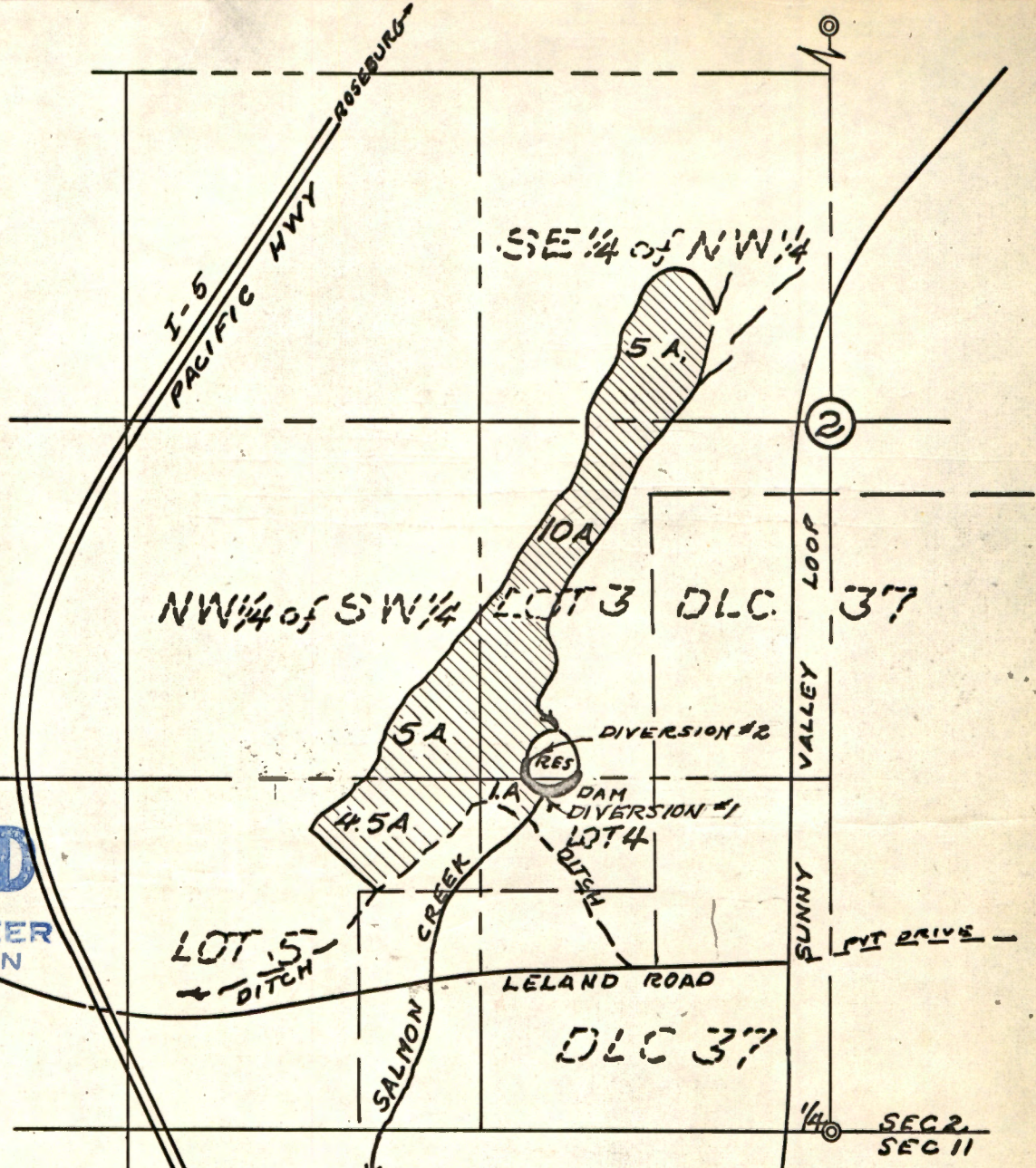

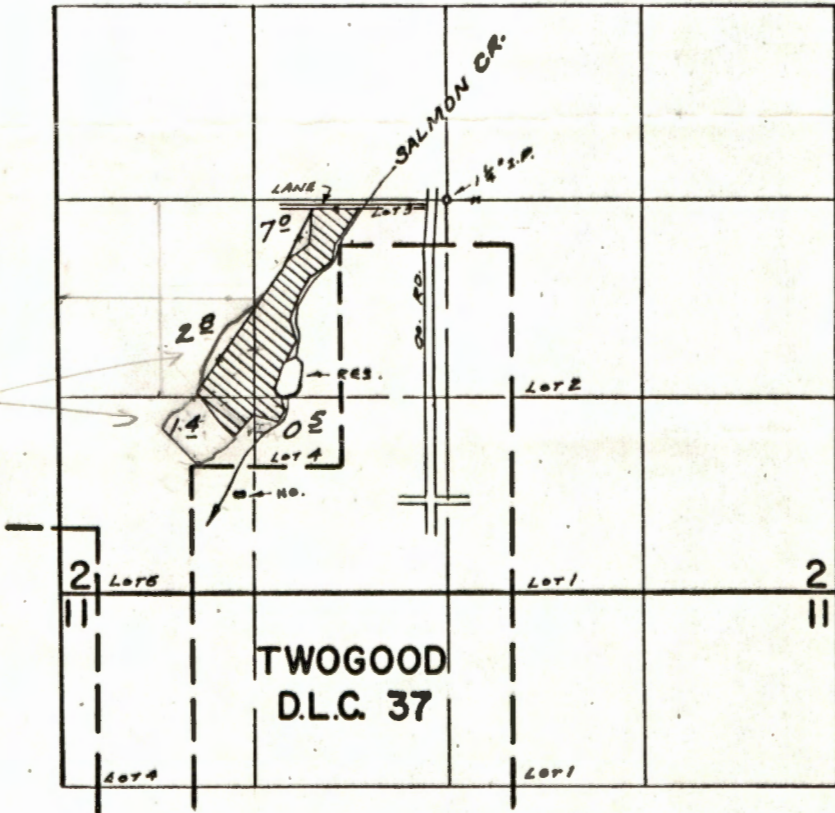
