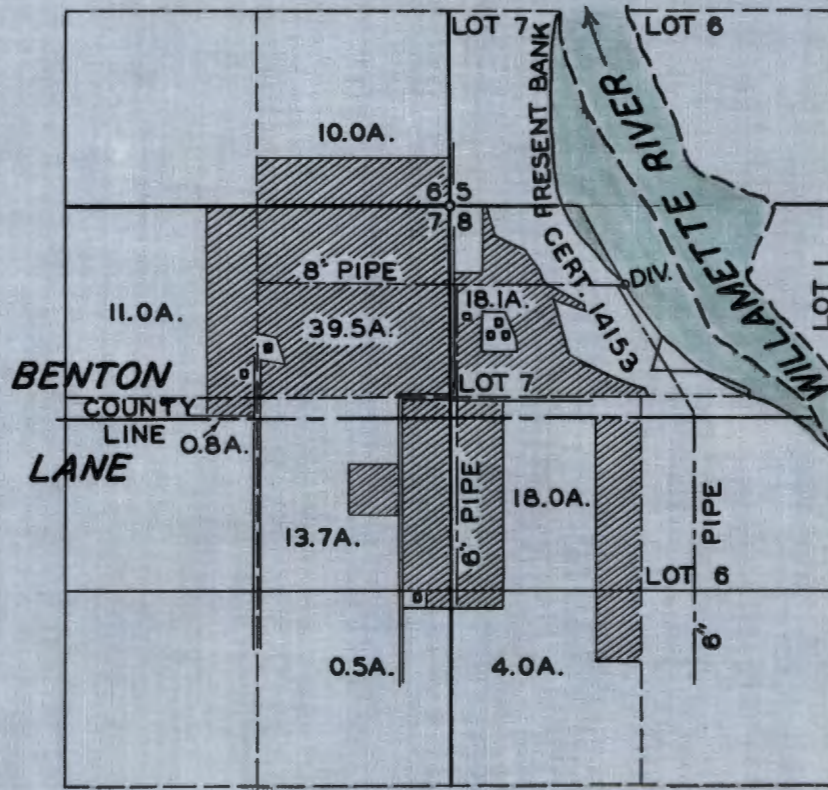

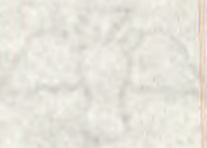

Dear Sir:

This will acknowledge receipt of the affidavits of abandonment to clear our records of Ground Water Registration Claims No. GR-1048, GR-3796, GR-3797, GR-3798, GR-3799, and GR-4154, and a listing of the number of acres of primary and supplemental irrigation from each of the 8 wells filed on in application No. G-4433 in each quarter-quarter section.

Applications No. G-4458 and G-4459 are now in satisfactory form for approval by issuance of permits.

When entering the new listing of acreages for application No. G-4433 into the records, I found 3 Ground Water Registration Claims No. GR-3080, GR-3081, and GR-3082 filed in the name of L. M. Talbott for the irrigation of a total of 39.5 acres. This 39.5 acres is now being filed on as primary irrigation. Inasmuch as these Ground Water Registration Claims were not listed in item No. 18 as being supplemented from the wells, I am enclosing 3 more affidavits of abandonment for Mr. Carson 'dams' signature.

A total of 227 acres of primary irrigation exists under permits No. 17216 and 17253 and Ground Water Registration No. GR-4174, GR-4175, and GR-4176. Item No. 12 on the application describes a total of 242.3 acres of supplemental irrigation. In no case can the number of acres of supplemental irrigation filed on in this application exceed the number of acres of primary irrigation under the earlier rights in any quarter-quarter section. I am enclosing copies of the maps of the earlier rights to show the location and number of acres from each source for each quarter-quarter section.

Item No. 8 on the application and the map must be amended to describe the supplemental irrigation in agreement with the rights of record.

Water is pumped from this high water channel of the Willamette River at one point only. In making the survey I found a total of 35.6 acres in Lot-7 of section 8. However there was a certificate issued to a Mr. Kuehner several years back for 17.5 acres so I have eliminated this amount and the outline of that field as shown by the survey of Cummings, leaving 18.1 acres to the credit of Adams. This land was always owned by Adams but was included in Kuehners application as he had to cross the Adams land to get to the river for the diversion.

Pump, Fairbanks-Morse, 8"x6" Cent. Belt connected to a 70 HP. Cletrac Tractor.

Pipe line to the West is 8" steel and the two to the South are 6" steel. The permittee runs his line South and East and hooks into the Kuehner pipe line.

Claims to own 4000' of 4", 9000' of 3" and 3000' of 2½" lateral pipe.

Has 150 sprinklers, but uses about 120 at a time. Said to be 15 gallon capacity.

Pump is said to be rated at 2200 gpm. Information from permittee.

Suction lift approx. 12'. Discahrge lift approx. 8'.

Tied the survey to what the permittee claims is the location of the section corner to sections 5-6-7-8. Also tied to several 1/16th corners.

This land is located in both Benton and Lane Counties.

This will acknowledge receipt of your application for a permit to appropriate water from Willamette River for the irrigation of 147 acres of land, together with the statutory recording fee of \$5.00 for which our Receipt No. 951 is enclosed.

The application has been filed and given No. 21394. It has been checked over and found to be incomplete.

For use in completing your application, I am enclosing herewith a sketch of the outlines of Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8, Township 15 South, Range 4 West showing the location of the Willamette River through Section 8 and the outline of the lands irrigated under Permit No. 12753 in the name of Richard C. Kuehner.

On this plat you should show to scale the location of the land to be irrigated in each 40 acre tract and the acreage in each 40 acre tract as shown on Page 7 of the enclosed copy of the Rules and Regulations of the State Engineer.
