Describe planned actions: All Columbia River Diversions have existing fish screens installed meeting NOAA standards in place as of 2022, or will have compliant fish screens installed prior to being included on the annual proposed use map for beneficial use of mitigation use water.
- X Excavation or clearing of banks will be kept to a minimum to protect riparian or streamside areas.

Describe planned actions and additional permits required for project implementation: No new construction is proposed at PODs A-C and E-M. All excavation at POD D will be completed in compliance with the conditions of the diversion owners permit granted by the United States Army Corps of Engineers.

Describe planned actions and additional permits required for project implementation: No improvements are anticipated to require work in waterways of the State. Should improvements require in-water work, all work will be performed after any necessary federal and state permits are granted and will remain in compliance with applicable state and federal permitting agencies and the applicable in-water work permits.

Describe planned actions: No improvements are anticipated at PODs A-C and E-M. All construction and improvements to POD D will be in compliance with applicable state and federal permitting agencies and applicable permits.

Place of Use Acreage

As part of this application, the Mid-Columbia Water Commission is identifying a new exterior boundary (referred to as the "Mid-Columbia Mitigation Region Boundary"), within which the mitigation use water supplies may be used on an annual basis. The actual place of use and rate of use on an annual basis will be reported to OWRD by an annual reporting deadline of February 14 for the upcoming irrigation season. Lands not included in the annual place of use map submitted on or before February 14 will not be included within the authorized place of use for mitigation use water rights for that year even though they are within the broader Mid-Columbia Mitigation Region Boundary and even though these lands may have received mitigation use water in previous

years. The final place of use, as well as total primary and total supplemental acreages, will be detailed prior to the final proof survey. Lands that do not utilize water under this permit shall not be included in the final proof survey nor included on the interactive water rights map of the Oregon Water Resources Department.

Proposed Period of Use as related to Division 33 Mitigation

The Mid-Columbia Water Commission proposes a period of use from March 1 to November 1 of each year. Water from the Columbia River will be subject to mitigation from April 15 to September 30, as required by OAR 690-033. From March 1 to April 14 and from October 1 to November 1 of each year, the Mid-Columbia Water Commission may pump from the Columbia River without securing or providing proof of mitigation. Otherwise, the Mid-Columbia Water Commission will secure mitigation at the appropriate level required by regulating agencies to pump Columbia River water from April 15 to September 30. Sources of mitigation are documented and reported to OWRD prior to the start of the mitigation season, and the pumping rate during the mitigation season will be directly proportionate to the mitigation secured for that mitigation season. The period for mitigation requirements is currently 169 days of the proposed period of use. The Mid-Columbia Water Commission has options agreements in place to secure mitigation for up to the maximum rate of 27 cfs for the 169-day period of use over the 5-year development period of the permit.

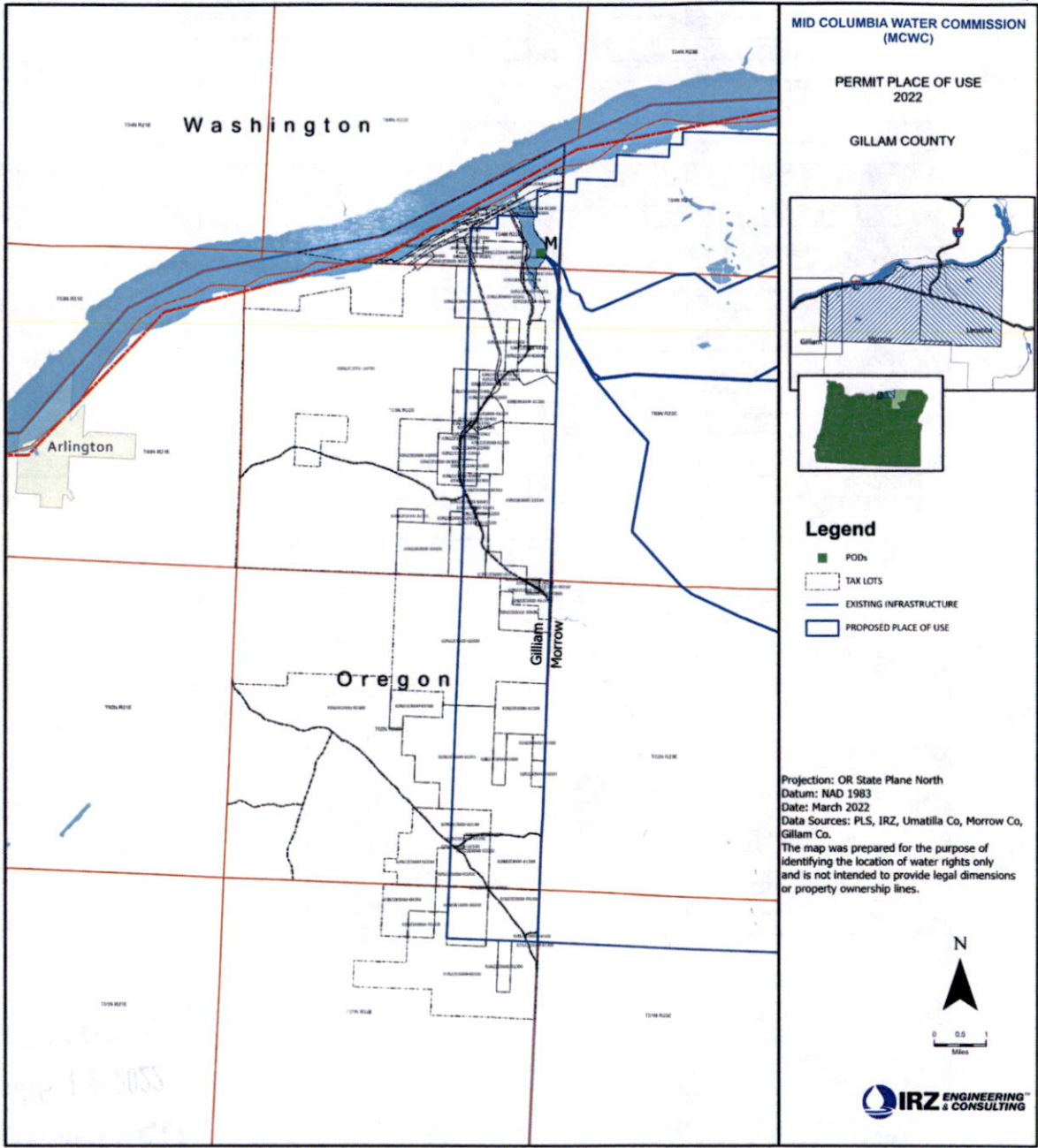

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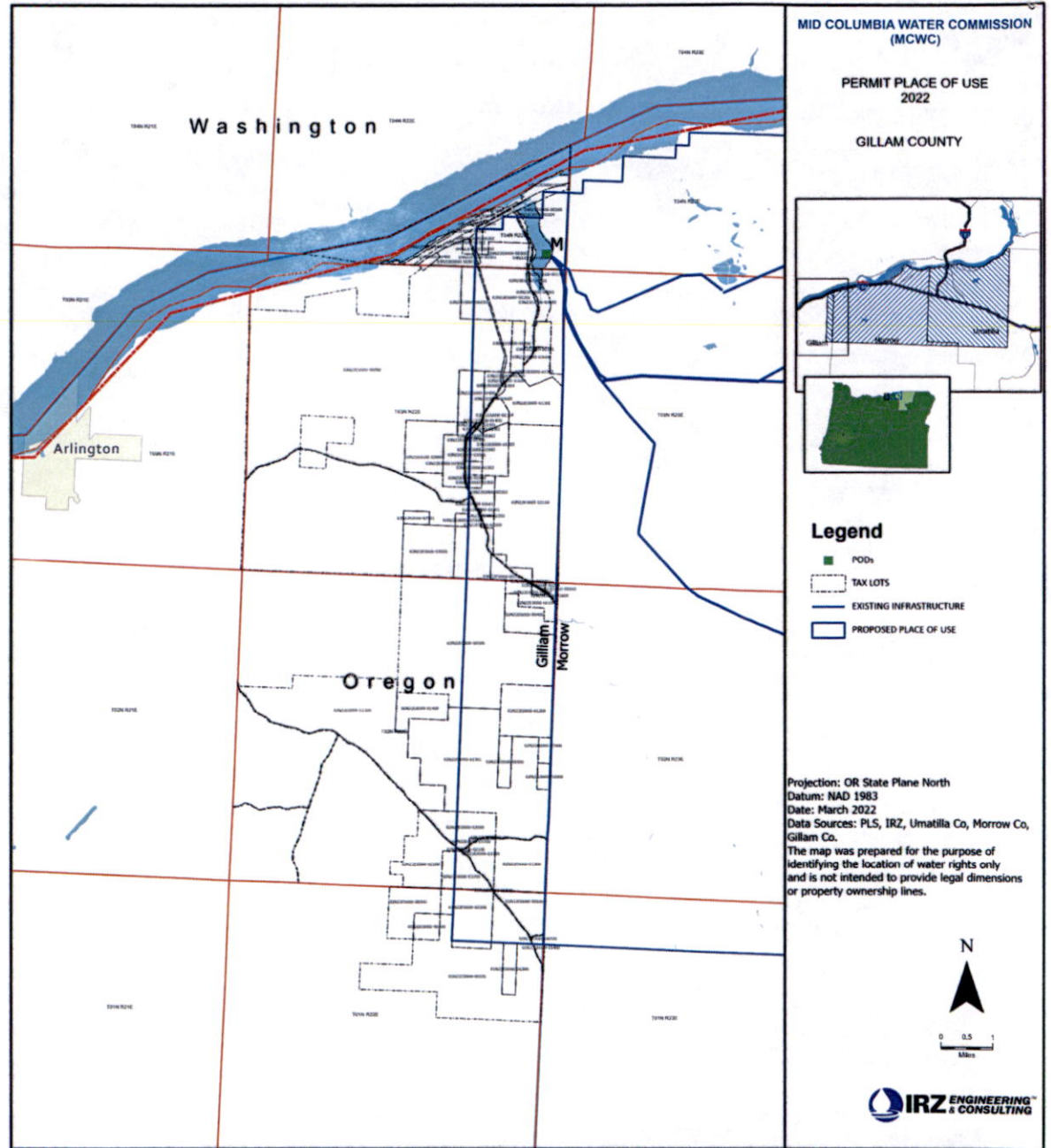

CAPITAL COST FEASIBILITY STUDY

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BACKGROUND

Port of Umatilla (POU) contracted with IRZ Consulting of Hermiston, Oregon to complete a feasibility study. The purpose of the study was to determine the approximate capital cost of constructing a pipeline in northwestern Umatilla County, Oregon. The pipeline would convey water from the Columbia River to Ordnance. The total capacity of the system would be 45 cubic feet per second (cfs). The study was to consider an entirely new pipeline with necessary pump station and is referred to herein as the Ordnance Multi-Use Pipeline (45cfs). After contracting with IRZ, Umatilla County acquired the Intake Purchase Agreement and the Port of Umatilla notified IRZ that they would like IRZ to just finish work already started. In order to quickly finish, cost estimates were derived from other similar project instead of getting new quotes for material in this project.

SYSTEM DESCRIPTION

Layout of System Serving the Ordnance

The total length of the pipeline from the river to the end at on Ordnance would be about five and a half miles. The major obstacles for the pipeline include crossings of Highway 730, and the West Extension canal,. There are also a couple other minor farm road crossings.

The pipeline would consist of 2,720 feet 42 inch steel, 700 feet of 42 inch 125PSI PVC, 25,930 feet of 42 inch 100PSI PVC. The first section of pipeline from the river south would be steel because of pressure requirements. The pipeline reaches its peak elevation of around 664 feet at about 18,600 feet from the river. The minimum allowable pressure at this point is 10 psi while the resulting design pressure at this point is 16 psi.

River Pump Station

The system would require a new pump station on the Columbia River. The pump station would be located adjacent to the existing Amstad Farms river pump station. The system would share Amstad Farms intake screens and pipe. The used portion of the intake would be purchased or leased from Amstad Farms. The Amstad Farms intake screen and manifold will have 30 cfs of capacity beyond the maximum pumping rate for Amstad Farms. It is anticipated that during periods when Amstad Farms is not pumping at its full capacity that additional capacity in the intake may be leased up to a total of 45 cfs for the new system. The new pipeline as considered herein would have a capacity of 45 cfs.

The new River Pump Station would have a total capacity of 45 cfs (20,200 gpm) at a total head of 490 feet. The river pump station would likely require an upgrade to the electrical substation that currently serves the Amstad Farms station. The system will not need any additional booster pumps to convey water from the river to the delivery points.

COST ESTIMATE - SYSTEM TO SUPPLY WATER TO ORDNANCE

Capital Costs of the System to serve Ordnance

These cost estimates were based on experience with agricultural irrigation system pump station and pipeline construction in the Columbia Basin and should be considered feasibility level approximations. It is prudent, in studies of this scale, to account for unforeseen challenges and expenses by including a contingency cost. A contingency of 15% was determined reasonable for this study. There is also an additional 15% to cover the prevailing wage if required, 5% for engineering services (Surveying, Design, Construction Management) and 5% for project management based on the size and complexity of the proposed system. This cost does not expressly include expenses for obtaining easements and crossing agreements, above that which might be typical. A summary of the estimated capital costs for the project is found in Table 1. The estimated total capital cost for this system is **\$13,985,000**.

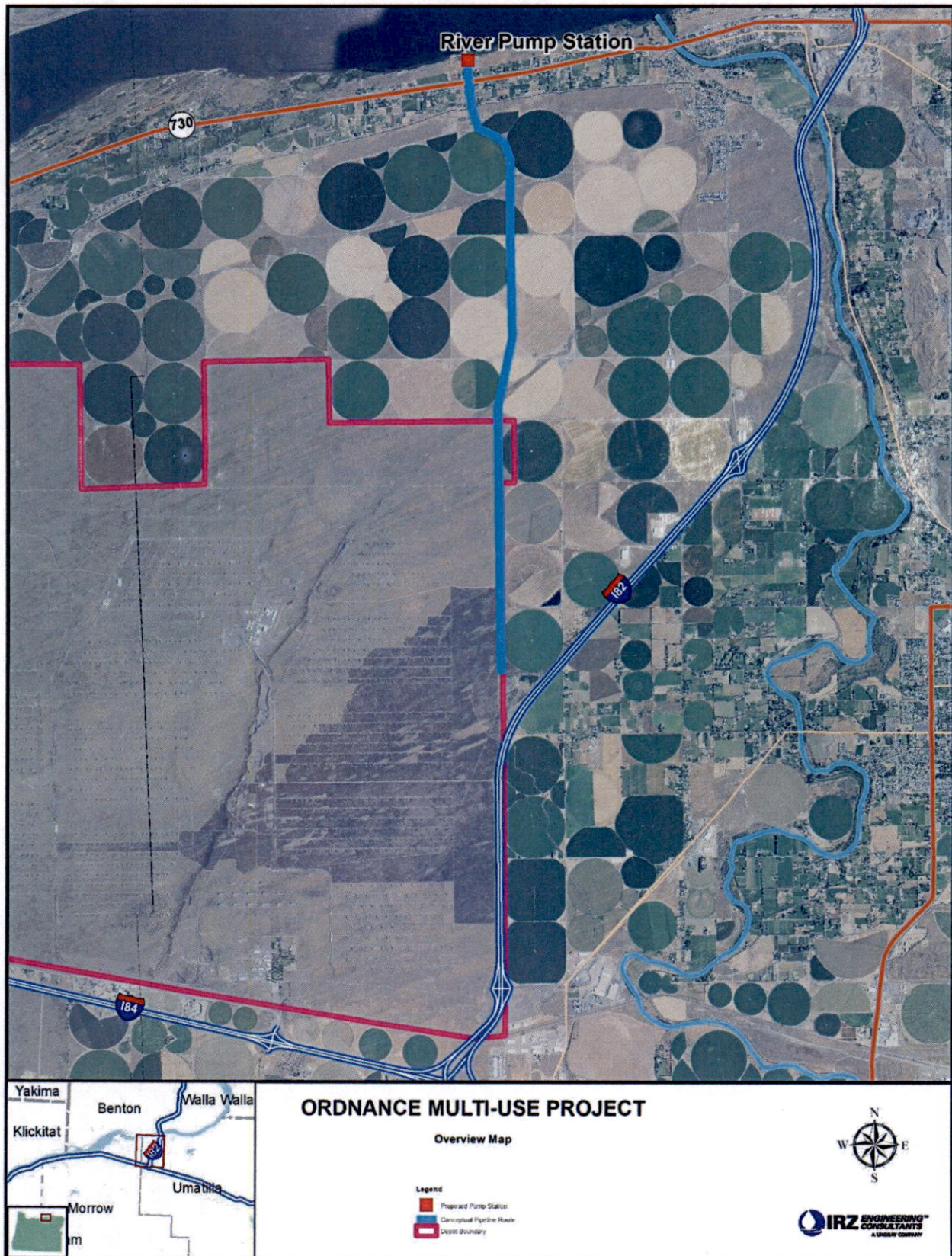
Energy Costs of the System to supply water to Ordnance

The estimated energy usage for all users served by this system will be about 670 kWh per acre-foot of water pumped. The estimated energy cost will be about \$34 per acre-foot. This estimate is based on the system running at full capacity and a total energy cost of \$0.05 per kWh.

 - Number of acres per Quarter/Quarter and hatching to indicate area of use if for primary irrigation, supplemental irrigation, or nursery
 - Location of main canals, ditches, pipelines or flumes (if well is outside of the area of use)

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Water-Use Permit Application Processing

1. Completeness Determination

The Department evaluates whether the application and accompanying map contain all of the information required under OAR 690-310-0040 and OAR 690-310-0050. The Department also determines whether the proposed use is prohibited by statute. If the Department determines that the application is incomplete, all fees have not been paid, or the use is prohibited by statute, the application and all fees submitted are returned to the applicant.

2. Initial Review

The Department reviews the application to determine whether water is available during the period requested, whether the proposed use is restricted or limited by rule or statute, and whether other issues may preclude approval of or restrict the proposed use. An Initial Review (IR) containing preliminary determinations is mailed to the applicant. The applicant has 14 days from the mailing date to withdraw the application from further processing and receive a refund of all fees paid minus \$310. The applicant may put the application on hold for up to 180 days and may request additional time if necessary.

3. Public Notice

Within 7 days of the mailing of the initial review, the Department gives public notice of the application in the weekly notice published by the Department at www.oregon.gov/owrd. The public comment period is 30 days from publication in the weekly notice.

4. Proposed Final Order Issued

The Department reviews any comments received, including comments from other state agencies related to the protection of sensitive, threatened or endangered fish species. Within 60 days of completion of the IR, the Department issues a Proposed Final Order (PFO) explaining the proposed decision to deny or approve the application. A PFO proposing approval of an application will include a draft permit, and may request additional information or outstanding fees required prior to permit issuance.

5. Public Notice

Within 7 days of issuing the PFO, the Department gives public notice in the weekly notice. Notice includes information about the application and the PFO. Protest must be received by the Department within 45 days after publication of the PFO in the weekly notice. Anyone may file a protest. The protest filing fee is \$480.00 for the applicant and \$950.00 for non-applicants. Protests are filed on approximately 10 percent of Proposed Final Orders. If a protest is filed the Department will attempt to settle the protest but will schedule a contested case hearing if necessary.

6. Final Order Issued

If no protests are filed, the Department can issue a Final Order within 60 days of the close of the period for receiving protest. If the application is approved, a permit is issued. The permit specifies the details of the authorized use and any terms, limitations or conditions that the Department deems appropriate

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
