RE: WATER MEASURING DEVICE NOTICE

This notice is to inform you of the need to install a measuring device at the point of diversion on Clark Creek. Your point of diversion, as identified below, does not have an adequate measuring device to allow for proper regulation of water use. Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 540.045(1)(a) authorizes the watermaster to regulate the distribution of water among users in accordance with existing water rights of record. A workable measuring device is necessary for water management and to ensure compliance with your water right.

The point of diversion from Clark Creek, authorized by Certificate 7404, is located in the NENW of Section 26, T33S, R5W, W.M.

ORS 540.310 and Oregon Administrative Rule 690-250-0060 provide the authority for the Department to require the measuring device. Pursuant to ORS 540.320, the measuring device must be installed within ten (10) days from the mailing of this notice. **After November 28, 2014 (ten days from the mailing of this notice), the watermaster may regulate off your use of water and prohibit you from diverting water until an approved and workable measuring device is installed and operating properly.**


Prior to installation, you are required to get approval from the watermaster for the type and configuration of the measuring device. The watermaster may approve an alternate plan or construction schedule under certain circumstances. The watermaster should be contacted if other arrangements are needed.

ORS 540.710 provides that no person shall willfully open, close, change or interfere with any lawfully established headgate or water box or willfully use water or divert water into or through the ditch of the person which has been lawfully denied water by a watermaster or other competent authority. Violation of ORS 540.710 is punishable, upon conviction, by a fine or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six months or both, and may also be subject to assessment of civil penalties under ORS 536.900.


