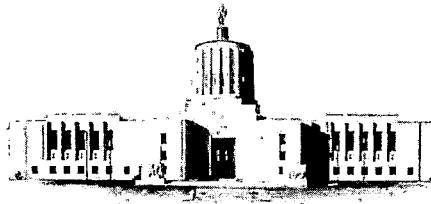

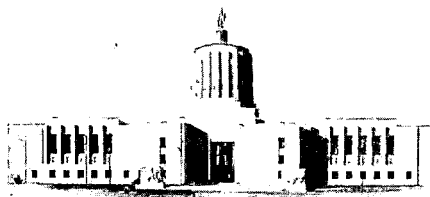



Dear Mr. Crook:

This will acknowledge your application for a permit to appropriate 0.26 cubic foot of water per second from two unnamed creeks and Pistol River for the irrigation of 19.9 acres and the watering of livestock, the accompanying tracing, legal description, and fees in the sum of \$25 for which our receipt numbered 733 is enclosed.

Your application has been examined and filed under file number 39800. During examination of your application, it is noted that water will be supplied to the livestock at Diversion Point No. 4 by digging a sump or small basin in the creek channel at the point of diversion. The construction of such a pool in the creek would not constitute a diversion of water for livestock watering purposes, and the livestock already have a natural right to drink from any source of water to which they have access. Unless you intend to make a physical diversion of water from the stream and supply it to the livestock in a trough, pond, or by some other means, I believe that this portion of your project should be deleted from your application.

It is noted in Item 12 that you do not propose to begin construction on your project until April 1, 1966. The statutes require that you make a beginning of construction on or before one year from the date of issuance of the permit in approval of your application. I suggest that you amend Item 12 or withdraw your application until you are prepared to make a beginning of the development within one year from the date of issuance of the permit.

It is noted in Items 4, 5, and 6 that you refer to an attached sheet. I believe that this information should be included on the application form. We have, therefore, amended your application accordingly.
