

PROPOSED CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM V. CROOK ARCH ROCK SOUTH PISTOL RIVER, OREGON 97444

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED CREEK, a tributary of PISTOL RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 6.5 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 37855. The date of priority is MARCH 6, 1973. The right is limited to not more than 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 29, T 38 S, R 14 W, W.M.; 5 FEET SOUTH AND 490 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 2 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) 5.0 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 1.5 ACRES
SECTION 29
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 14 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.



Dear Mr. Crook:

Thank you for sending us your statements to the effect that the construction work of your project has been completed.

I do not know which water right you are referring to in your letter of November 14, 1975, but if it is a perfected and developed right, as evidenced by a certificate of water right, an application may be submitted by the owner of the land upon which the diversion point is located requesting a change in point of diversion. The Watermaster, our field representative, would be advised of the request and he would have to investigate the possibility of the change effecting other water right users. If the change would not injure an existing water right and if the request were granted, the date of priority would not be lost.

If I have misunderstood your letter and you are referring to your permit number 37855 which grants the right to the use of water from an unnamed creek for the irrigation of 6.5 acres, we will have to be advised that water has been used to the full extent intended and a field inspection of the project made by this office before any changes can be made.

I have enclosed an assignment form for your use. If just a portion of permit 37855 is to be assigned to a new owner, the legal description of the property whould also be included on the assignment form. It is to be signed and returned along with a \$2.00 recording fee.
