Rulemaking Need: Legislation

Implement recent legislation

- House Bill 2145 (2021): Well construction modernization
- House Bill 3030 (2019)/Senate Bill 688 (2019): Temporary licenses for spouses of members of armed forces
- House Bill 4061 (2022): Extending timeline for agency to issue a notice of violation



Rulemaking Need: Penalties

Penalty alignment across Divisions

Major and minor penalties for well drillers and other than well drillers

Division 260 – Other Than Well Drillers	240 (Current) –	Divisions 225 & 240 (Proposed) – Well Drillers
Minor - \$50	Minor - \$25	Minor - \$50
Major - \$200	Major - \$50	Major - \$200




Rulemaking Need: Other

Restore deleted rule

 Dedicated measuring tube requirements (OAR 690-215-0200)

Other "Housekeeping"

- Spelling, grammar, clarity
- Figure updates, improved resolution





HB 2145 (2021) Background

Oregon Legislature passed HB 2145 (2021) to

- Modernize well construction program
- Protect Oregon's groundwater
- Provide well construction industry with timely assurance work is consistent with State requirements

Effective dates ranging from January 1, 2022, to July 1, 2024



HB 2145 (2021) Implementation

Implement HB 2145

- Add licensing requirements for drillers
- Require exempt use map to be submitted by driller
- Groundwater use recording fee paid by driller





HB 2145 (2021) Implementation

Implement HB 2145 (2021)

- Increase start card notification and info/data requirements
- Increase well report info/data requirements
- Include timeline for OWRD to review 100% of well reports for compliance, notify drillers of any deficiencies





HB 3030 (2019)/SB 688 (2019) Implementation

Implement HB 3030 (2019)

- Authorizes OWRD to issue a two-year temporary well driller license if person meets statutory requirements
- Temporary authorization is not renewable.

Implement SB 688 (2019)

 Directs OWRD to report to interim committee related to veterans on implementation of HB 3030 (2019)



HB 4061 (2022) Implementation

Implement HB 4061 (2022)

Extend the time period for issuing a Notice of Violation (NOV) after becoming aware of a violation from five calendar days to ten business days.





Rulemaking Progress & Next Steps



Progress to Date

Rules Advisory Committee (RAC) formation

 20 members (well drillers, consultants, vocational educators/ trainers, local government, tribes, environmental NGOs)

RAC Meetings

- 3 hybrid meetings held to date (Dec. 13, Jan. 11, Feb. 15)
- 1 hybrid meeting remaining (Mar. 15)

Groundwater Advisory Committee

Provided update (Feb. 21)

- Convene final RAC meeting March 15
- Publish Notice of Public Hearing; Start 30-day Comment Period – April 3
- Present to GWAC mid-April
- Convene Public Hearing (hybrid, Salem) April 27
- Present proposed rules to WRC June 15/16
- Rule effective date July 1, 2023
