#### PUBLIC NOTICE OF WATER USE REQUESTS May 30, 2023

This publication lists agency activities requiring public notice. It also describes public comment processes and deadlines. Types of water use requests in this week's Public Notice include:

- \* **Permit Application Initial Reviews, Proposed Final Orders, and Final Orders** Applications for permits to use, store, divert or pump surface water or groundwater. Includes applications by the state Departments of Fish & Wildlife, Environmental Quality or Parks and Recreation for water to be used and kept in-channel.
- Applications for Allocation of Conserved Water
  Applications made by a water user who conserves water to use a portion of the conserved water on additional lands, lease or sell the water, or dedicate the water to instream use.

Applications requesting Department recognition of changes in point of appropriation, place of use and character of use under a ground water certificate of registration.



## **Initial Review and Proposed Final Orders**

The following pages of this notice list permit applications that the Department is evaluating for compliance with state water law. Public participation and comment is encouraged. Opportunities for public involvement vary according to the stage of the permit evaluation. Ground water permit applications in the Deschutes Basin (Basin 5) may seek to provide mitigation pursuant to the Deschutes Ground Water Mitigation Rules.

## Initial Review Stage (IR)

The Department has given the applicant an initial review of water-use restrictions, water availability and other limitations that affect the agency's decision on whether to issue a permit. The Department welcomes comments from interested persons, agencies and organizations on the proposed water use. **The comment deadline for initial reviews appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Thursday, June 29, 2023.** Although we cannot respond individually to all comments, each will be considered as the agency makes its decision regarding proposed allocations.

## Proposed Final Order Stage (PFO)

The proposed final order is the Department's penultimate decision on the water use request. The PFO documents the agency's decision through specific findings, including review of comments received. If appropriate, it includes a draft permit specifying any conditions or restrictions on the use. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$35. (Any person paying \$35 to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued.) PFO's may be viewed free of charge online at: <u>http://apps.wrd.state.or.us/apps/wr/wrinfo/</u>. Those disagreeing with the Department's decision as expressed in the PFO have 45 days to file a protest.

## The protest deadline for proposed final orders appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Friday, July 14, 2023.

The protest filing fee is \$480 for the applicants and \$950 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest are included in the PFO. Persons who support the PFO may file a "standing" fee of \$270 to retain the ability to participate in future proceedings relating to an application. Before participation in a hearing is allowed, an additional \$680 will be required to request to participate as a party or limited party.

If a protest or comment deadline falls on a day that the office is closed, then the next open business day automatically becomes the deadline date.

## **Applications for Allocation of Conserved Water**

The following applications for allocation of conserved water have been received pursuant to ORS 537.455 to 537.500 and OAR Chapter 690, Division 18. In reviewing the applications, the Department will consider whether the diversion for the uses allowed under the original water right will be reduced by the conservation project, whether existing water rights will be protected from injury, and whether the project is in compliance with local comprehensive land use plans.

## Notice of Application for Allocation of Conserved Water CW-136

On May 1, 2023, Tumalo Irrigation District (TID), 64697 Cook Avenue, Bend, OR 97701, filed an application for Allocation of Conserved Water for Certificates (Certs.) 95175, 95176, and 95177 under ORS 537.470. Cert. 95175 is for a total of 50.652 cubic feet per second (CFS) from Tumalo Creek, tributary of the Deschutes River for Irrigation of 5801.5 acres, domestic use including livestock. Cert. 95176 is for 129.846 CFS from Tumalo Creek with any deficiency to be made up by diverting no more than 40.0 CFS from Crater Creek, 34.0 CFS from Little Crater Creek, and 1.0 CFS from Three Springs Branches 6590.6 acre-equivalent of irrigation, supplemental irrigation, and other uses. Cert. 95177 is for 30,331.13 acre-feet (AF) from Crescent Lake Reservoir for 7381.2 acre-equivalent of supplemental irrigation and other uses. The conservation project proposes to pipe the open un-lined West Branch Columbia Southern West, Spaulding, North Spaulding, and Beasley laterals with HDPE pipe conserving the following quantities of water: Cert. 95175, 238.88 AF / up to 0.655 cfs with priority dates of 8/5/1900, 9/1900, 4/28/1905, 5/27/1907, and 6/1/1907; Cert. 95176, 194.38 AF / up to 1.221 cfs with a priority date of 10/29/1913; and Cert. 95177, 384.23 AF with a priority date of 4/7/1911. TID proposes 100% of the conserved water to be protected instream.

Any interested person may submit written comments directly related to CW-136 within 20 days of the last date of newspaper publication, being by 5:00pm on June 24, 2023. Comments should be sent to ACW Program, Water Resources Department, 725 Summer Street NE, Suite A, Salem, OR 97301-1266. OWRD will review all comments received when determining whether to approve the proposed ACW.

## **Establishment of Mitigation Credits in the Deschutes Basin**

ORS 537.746 authorizes the Department to award mitigation credits in the Deschutes Basin to approved mitigation projects. Mitigation credits may be used in the Deschutes Basin, specifically the Deschutes Ground Water Study Area, to mitigate for the impacts of ground water use on surface water flows. Pursuant to OAR Chapter 690, Division 521, upon receipt of notification of a mitigation project, the Department shall give public notice of the intent to establish mitigation credits.

The public is invited to comment on establishment of mitigation credits for the project(s) described below. Comments must be received within 21 days of the date of this public notice. Comments should address the award of mitigation credits to the proposed project and its use for mitigation purposes. Included in this public notice is a preliminary determination as to the amount of mitigation credits that may be available from the proposed project.

## Emergency Water Use (Drought) Applications (OAR 690-019-0040)

When a drought is declared under ORS 536.740, the Director is authorized to issue emergency use permits to replace water not available under an existing right because of the drought. The Director shall approve an application for emergency water use upon findings that the proposed use will not cause injury to existing water rights and will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest. OAR 690-019-0040(3). In evaluating whether the proposed use will impair or be detrimental to the public interest, the Director shall consider the factors described in OAR 690-310-0120 and 690-310-0130; and

- a) The need for water because of the drought emergency; and
- b) The short-term nature of the proposed emergency use.

The following is a list of emergency water use permit applications recently filed, or which have recently received a final order, pursuant to OAR 690-019-0040. For any emergency use permits issued, the expiration date will not exceed the term of the Governor's declared drought or one year. The Director will consider all comments received concerning the use, or proposed use, under the emergency use permit throughout the life of the permit. (OAR 690-019-0040(4)(b))

## Proposed Final Orders Regarding Applications for Extensions of Time for Water Right Permits

ORS 537.230, 537.248, 537.630 and 539.010 authorize the Water Resources Department to extend time limits contained in water right permits for completing construction of water development projects and applying water to full beneficial use. Procedures for permit holders to apply for extensions and for the Department to evaluate and determine whether or not to approve extensions of time are contained in OAR 690-320-0010 for extensions filed before July 1, 2001, and in OAR 690-315-0010 for extensions filed on or after July 1, 2001.

Proposed Final Orders (PFO's) are the Department's preliminary decision on extension requests. They document the agency's decision through specific findings. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$35. (Any person paying to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued). PFO's may be viewed for free at the Department's Salem Office or at the appropriate watermaster district office.

## **Extension of Time Public Notice and Comment Procedures**

Written comments on or written protests against a PFO must be submitted on or before July 14, 2023. There is no fee for submission of comments. The protest filing fee is \$480 for the applicant and \$950 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest will be sent with copies of the PFO.

## **Applications for Instream Lease**

ORS 537.348 authorizes a water right holder to lease their existing water right(s) to instream use for a limited time. For the term of the lease, the water right holder agrees to suspend use of water under the original right. The state is the trustee for water rights leased for instream use. OAR 690-077-0077 requires that the Department public notice the lease applications.

The deadline for submitting claims of injury to existing water rights or enlargement of the original right against a lease application is June 20, 2023. Parties to the lease, including the Department, will review any such claims before the lease is finalized. ## **Transfer Applications: Temporary Transfer**

The holder of a water right subject to transfer may request to temporarily change the place of use of the water for up to 5 years and, if necessary to convey the water, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation. The Department shall approve the request provided it does not cause injury to existing water rights or enlarge the water use. If after the change is approved, it is found to cause injury, the approved change may be revoked. The use of water reverts to the authorized place of use upon expiration of the temporary change.

Alternatively, you may use our new Public Comment tool available on our website. On the Water Rights Information Query Results page, use the "Submit a Public Comment" link, or under 'View all Scanned Documents' use the "Submit a Public Comment" link.

\* We are required by law to charge a fee of \$35 to mail a copy of proposed and final orders on a pending permit or permit extension applications to any interested person. Please include a check made out to the Oregon Water Resources Department in the amount of \$35 for each type of order you would like mailed to you. This fee entitles you to also receive a copy of the final order, when issued. Copies of proposed and final orders are also available for viewing (at no charge) at our Salem office, at the local watermaster office, or online.
