Project Implementation Update

I. Introduction

Staff will update the Commission on Department efforts to implement numerous projects associated with the 2021-2023 budget and legislation. This is an informational report.

II. Background

In 2021, the Oregon Legislature made water a major focus area, adding significant new staff capacity across many Water Resources Department programs as well as creating new responsibilities for the agency. The Legislature made additional water resources-related investments during the second Special Session in December 2021.

Over the course of the biennium the Department has focused substantial energy on recruiting, hiring, and onboarding people into many positions and carrying out the added tasks. Staff have made an ongoing effort to keep the Commission, Legislators, stakeholders, and the general public informed about the status of implementing this significant workload.

In February 2023, the Commission was briefed by managers in the Field Services Division and Information Services Section, and by the Records Officer for the Records Management Section, on work priorities and projects.

During this agenda item the Commission will receive a detailed briefing by the manager of the Planning, Collaboration, and Investments Section (see Attachment 1).

Planning, Collaboration, and Investments Section 2021-23 Biennium Work Priorities and Projects

The Planning, Collaboration, and Investments (PCI) Section within the <u>Oregon Water Resources Department</u> (OWRD) builds partnerships and incentivizes Oregonians to pursue integrated and innovative solutions for addressing complex water challenges and an uncertain water future. We work to achieve a secure and sustainable water future, addressing instream and out-of-stream needs for all Oregonians and Oregon's environment, economy, communities, and cultures as outlined in <u>Oregon's Integrated Water Resources Strategy</u> and OWRD's <u>2019-24 Strategic Plan</u>. To transparently communicate what we are doing and what we are currently not be able to do our priorities and projects for July 2021 through December 2023 are summarized below. Work anticipated during the 2023-25 biennium is dependent on the outcomes of the 2023 Legislative Session.

Ongoing Operations - Day-to-day work and standard section business that spans the biennium

- Annual funding cycles for Feasibility Study Grants (applications due fall 2021 and 2022)
- Annual funding cycles for Water Project Grants and Loans (applications due spring 2022 and 2023)
- Grant administration
- Partner with the <u>Upper Grande Ronde River Watershed Planning Partnership</u>, supported efforts to finalize the plan and seek state-recognition (achieved March 2022); now supporting plan implementation
- Partner with the <u>Mid-Coast Water Planning Partnership</u>, supported efforts to finalize their plan and seek state-recognition (achieved June 2022); now supporting plan implementation
- Partner with the <u>Lower John Day Place-Based Partnership</u>, supported efforts to finalize their plan and seek state-recognition (achieved June 2022); now supporting plan implementation
- Partner with the Harney Community-Based Water Planning Collaborative, supporting efforts to complete a
 draft groundwater plan, partner on next steps after the groundwater basin study, and transition focus to
 surface water planning
- Provide very limited technical assistance to the place-based planning groups; only what is necessary to help them finalize their plans
- Provide internal Department coordination in other priority basins (Deschutes and Willamette)

Work on Hold - Efforts put on hold due to lack of capacity and other priorities

- Additional recommended actions in the funding opportunities <u>Continuous Improvement Plan</u>
- Planning Assessment Element D (Assess the planning status, assets, and needs of the state and places across Oregon)
- Planning Assessment Element E (Together with partners, chart a path forward with specific recommended actions for future water resources planning in Oregon based on information gathered during assessment) *note: some of this work was done in the water planning legislative concept development work and State-Supported Regional Water Planning and Management Work Group
- More robust reactive technical assistance to place-based planning groups
- Proactive technical assistance (e.g., compilation of data packages for future planning)
- Monthly <u>virtual conversations</u> for shared learning by those interested in, doing, or supporting water planning
