## 2023 Legislative Session Update

### I. Introduction

During this informational report, staff will provide an update on the 2023 Legislative Session.

# II. Background

Department staff will brief the Commission with the most up-to-date information on legislation and budget items during the meeting. Information about the 2023 Legislative Session is online at <a href="https://www.oregonlegislature.com">www.oregonlegislature.com</a> and then clicking on the OLIS icon.

May 19 was the last day for measures to move out of second chamber committees; however, deadlines do not apply to measures in the Ways and Means, Revenue, and Rules Committees. See attachment 1 for the status of water-related legislation as of May 22. The Department will not know the full scope of its budget until the end of session; however, staff will provide an overview of what is known about the budget during the meeting.

#### III. Conclusion

The Constitutional Sine Die deadline for adjournment is June 25. Staff will keep the Commission apprised of important developments through the end of the Session.
