Oregon Legislature

- Senate 30 members
 - President of the Senate
- House of Representatives 60 members
 - Speaker of the House
- Caucus Leadership
 - House: Majority and Minority
 - Senate: Majority and Minority
- Committees
 - Chair







Long Session

- During odd numbered years,
- Organizational Days in second week of January
- Session start Jan 17
- May not exceed 160 days, unless extended by 2/3 vote
- Unlimited # of pre-session filed bills
- Address budget and policy issues





Legislation

- Almost 3,000 bills introduced;
- Tracked more than 500 bills
 - 200 still alive
- Many tracked due to relating to clauses
- Statewide bills related to employment, contracting, public records, rulemaking, etc.
- See attachment 1 for approximately 100 of the bills tracked

Budget: Proposed Investments (Water Availability Reporting System)

Field: 2 Assistant Watermasters

Program Analyst in Director's Office

\$425k Agrimet contract costs and stream gage maintenance

\$28k from PRISM and Google data (one-time)



Budget: Proposed Investments (American Rescue Plan Act)

\$800k Place-based Planning and \$500k fish passage

\$1 million Well Abandonment, Repair, and Replacement Fund

\$6 million Ordnance Project in Umatilla County

\$1.5 million fee-based programs; 8 water rights staff for 12 months

\$2.5 million flood methodology & inundation assessments

\$1 million Water Measurement Cost Share Fund

\$2.6 million surface water and groundwater data collection equipment



Budget: Proposed Investments (Funding in HB 2010 and HB 5043)

\$2 million for Place-Based Planning

\$1.2 million CTUIR Settlement & Complex Issues (one-time)

\$500k DOJ/OAH for protest backlog (one-time)

\$100k for voluntary groundwater agreements (plus position)



Budget: Proposed Reductions

1 Evapotranspiration Hydrologist

\$475k GF for Evapotranspiration Projects

\$250k GF Groundwater Studies Outreach

\$448k GF Groundwater Investigation Funds (Observation Wells)
