Budget Process and Timeline

Agency Request Budget

- Development in early 2024
- Agency working with Governor's Office on POPs for ARB
- Submitted and Published August 1

Governor's Recommended Budget

- Governor and CFO review ARB
- Use Governor's priorities, budget policies, and current law to make budget decisions
- GRB published in December 2024

Legislative Adopted Budget

- Legislative committees review GRB and hold public meeting
- Legislature determines and votes on budget
- Emergency board, special sessions

- Placeholder Water Right Transaction Fees and Dam Safety Annual Fee Shortfalls
- Placeholder Well Construction Program Fee Shortfalls



2025-27 Submitted POPs

Attachment 1: 2025-27 Budget Issues

- Early stages of POP development; ongoing conversations
- 1% General Fund Cap: \$1,022,150
- No cap on non-GF asks



Non-General Fund Potential POPs

- Shortfall: Well Construction-Related Fees Shortfalls
 - Start Card: \$975k | Licensing: \$51k
- Shortfall: Water Right Transactions and Dam Safety Fee Shortfalls
 - Water Rights: \$4.8M | Dam Safety: \$250k
- Package 070: Fee Shortfall Reduction Package
 - 13 FTE



Non-General Fund Potential POPs

- Harney CREP
- Grant Programs: Recapitalize Funding for Existing Programs
 - Feasibility Study: \$1M LRB | WPGL: \$20M LRB | WARRF: \$1M LBR
- Repurpose of uncommitted facilitation funds
 - Repurpose \$600k from 2023 appropriations
- ARPA Carryover



General Fund Potential POPs – Within GF Cap

- Information Technology Package: Business Analyst Capacity
 - 1 FTE; \$254k GF
- Human Resources and Workplace Safety Needs
 - 1 FTE; \$205k GF
- Budget Gap: Internal Audit Function
 - 1 FTE (split with OWEB); \$142k GF and OWEB \$142K OF
- Shortfall: State Scenic Waterways
 - \$303k GF
- Web Coordinator
 - 0.5 FTE; \$118k GF
