**1. Final Report on Portland Regional Water Supply**

Lorna Stickel, Director of Planning Water Bureau, briefed the Commission and responded to their questions on the Regional Water Supply Plan. The plan was recently endorsed by Portland area water providers. A sub-group of the participants in the plan have formed a consortium for water supply management. The plan provides a means for cooperative management in the metropolitan region. Jesse Lowman, Tualatin Valley Water District; and Dale Jutila, Clackamas Water District, spoke on their involvement in the plan's development.

## **2. Enforcement Report**

Dave Jarrett, Manager of the Enforcement Section, reported to the Commission on field enforcement activity in 1996. John Falk gave a talk and slide presentation on his work with the department's dam safety program; Tracy Eichenlaub reported on her duties and experiences as an inspector of monitoring wells; and Greg Beaman, District 1 Watermaster from St. Helens, spoke on his job and answered Commissioners' questions.

## **5. Willamette Basin Reservoir Study**

The department is working cooperatively with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to look into possible changes in the way the Corps manages the reservoirs for a variety of uses throughout the basin.
