Open Houses

The IWRS Project Team, together with agency field staff and local sponsors, will host a series of evening open houses throughout the state in 2010, serving three purposes:

- 1 To disseminate information about the state-wide strategy and to ensure that interested members of the public, elected officials and other attendees have information about the project, the timeline, and the many opportunities to participate.
- 2 To seek input from community members, in terms of water resource challenges, opportunities, and recommended actions.
- 3 To highlight successful examples of water resource solutions currently underway in Oregon communities.

An open house format with one or more tables serving as "stations" will allow participants to gather information, participate in conversations and brainstorming sessions with IWRS staff, and ask agency field staff (and other sponsor organizations) questions about current issues and projects.
