SALEM-- The Water Resources Commission's Ground Water Advisory Committee (GWAC) will meet on Wednesday, March 5, 2008 at 6:00 p.m. PST. Advice on Proposed Rules for Eola Hills Ground Water Limited Area, Polk and Yamhill Counties and Petes Mountain Area, Clackamas County

Doug Woodcock, Manager of the Ground Water Section, will present this action item. GWAC's advice is sought on the proposed rules.

The Water Resources Department is proposing administrative rules that establish special area standards for well construction and maintenance in the Eola Hills Ground Water Limited Area of Polk and Yamhill Counties and in the Petes Mountain Area of Clackamas County. For both areas, the proposed rules require the installation of dedicated measuring tubes in all water supply wells at the time of pump installation, pump repair, and/or pump replacement to provide an unobstructed conduit for lowering devices that measure water levels. The water levels recorded by the measuring devices provide essential data for determining the stability of the ground water resources in the areas.

Additionally, the rules propose that new water supply wells and newly deepened water supply wells in the Eola Hills Ground Water Limited Area be cased and sealed to within 100 feet of the bottom of the well for the purpose of eliminating movement of water in the well from shallow aquifers to deeper aquifers.

The Department is holding two public hearings on the proposed rules to obtain oral and written comments. The written comment period closes at 5 pm, Monday, March 10, 2008.
