This publication lists agency activities requiring public notice. It also describes public comment processes and deadlines. Types of water use requests in this week's Public Notice include:

- * **Permit Application Initial Reviews, Proposed Final Orders, and Final Orders**
Applications for permits to use, store, divert or pump surface water or groundwater. Includes applications by the state Departments of Fish & Wildlife, Environmental Quality or Parks and Recreation for water to be used and kept in-channel.
- * **Alternate Reservoir Applications (ORS 537.409)**
Applications for storage permits for small ponds filed under a simplified review process.
- * **Renewal of Aquifer Storage and Recovery (ASR) Limited Licenses**
- * **Transfer Preliminary Determinations**
Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, and character of use upon which the public may protest the application and Department's preliminary determination.
- * **Transfer Applications: Permit Amendments**
Requests to amend permits.
- * **Certificate Issuance**
Included in this section is a listing of recently issued water right certificates.
- * **Notice of Application to Split a Permit**
Request to assign all or part of a water right permit for irrigation, nursery, temperature control, stock watering, or agricultural water use and to issue replacement permit(s) to reflect an assignment from the current permit holder to one or more additional permit holders.

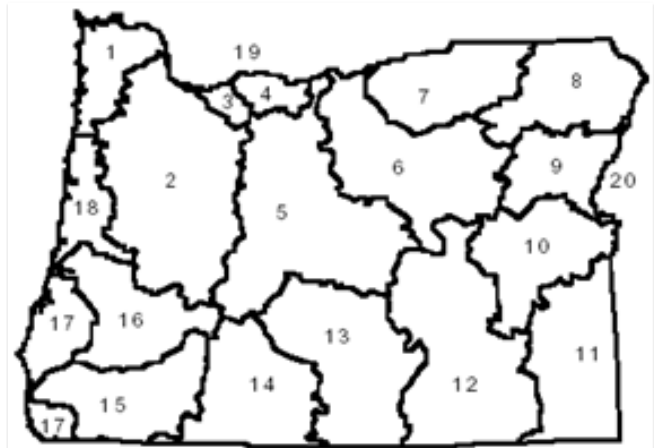

Initial Review and Proposed Final Orders

The following pages of this notice list permit applications that the Department is evaluating for compliance with state water law. Public participation and comment is encouraged. Opportunities for public involvement vary according to the stage of the permit evaluation.

Ground water permit applications in the Deschutes Basin (Basin 5) may seek to provide mitigation pursuant to the Deschutes Ground Water Mitigation Rules.

Initial Review Stage (IR)

The Department has given the applicant an initial review of water-use restrictions, water availability and other limitations that affect the agency's decision on whether to issue a permit. The Department welcomes comments from interested persons, agencies and organizations on the proposed water use.

The comment deadline for initial reviews appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Thursday, September 18, 2025. Although we cannot respond individually to all comments, each will be considered as the agency makes its decision regarding proposed allocations.

Proposed Final Order Stage (PFO)

The proposed final order is the Department's penultimate decision on the water use request. The PFO documents the agency's decision through specific findings, including review of comments received. If appropriate, it includes a draft permit specifying any conditions or restrictions on the use. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$53. (Any person paying \$53 to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued.) PFO's may be viewed free of charge online at: <http://apps.wrd.state.or.us/apps/wr/wrinfo/>. Those disagreeing with the Department's decision as expressed in the PFO have 45 days to file a protest.

The protest deadline for proposed final orders appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Friday, October 03, 2025.

The protest filing fee is \$720 for the applicants and \$1,425 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest are included in the PFO. Persons who support the PFO may file a "standing" fee of \$405 to retain the ability to participate in future proceedings relating to an application. Before participation in a hearing is allowed, an additional \$1,020 will be required to request to participate as a party or limited party.

If a protest or comment deadline falls on a day that the office is closed, then the next open business day automatically becomes the deadline date.

Alternate Reservoir Applications (ORS 537.409)

For alternate reservoir applications filed under ORS 537.409, the public is invited to comment within 60 days of this notice. The law provides that within 60 days after the Department provides public notice of the application, any person may submit detailed, legally obtained information in writing, requesting the Department to deny the application for a permit on the basis that the reservoir:

- (A) Would result in injury to an existing water right; or
- (B) Would pose a significant detrimental impact to existing fishery resources as determined on the basis of information submitted by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife.

Such comments must be submitted on or before October 18, 2025.

Renewal of Aquifer Storage and Recovery (ASR) Limited Licenses

ASR means the storage of water from a separate source that meets drinking water standards in a suitable aquifer for later recovery and not having as one of its primary purposes the restoration of the aquifer (ORS 537.531). The use of water for ASR testing purposes requires a limited license pursuant to ORS 537.534. The requirements and procedures of an ASR limited license are different than those for limited licenses pursuant to ORS 537.143. Only after completion of an ASR testing program under a limited license may an applicant apply for a permanent ASR permit. The appearance of a renewal request in the public notice commences a 30-day public comment period. Following the public comment period, the Department may request additional information regarding the renewal request, renew the limited license, renew the limited license with additional conditions, or deny the request.

An ASR Limited License may be renewed if the applicant demonstrates to the Director's satisfaction that further testing is necessary and that the applicant complied with the terms of the limited license. The standards, findings and process used in the license renewal process shall be as provided in OAR 690-350-0020. The Director may renew an ASR Limited License for a term of not more than 5 years.

Transfer Preliminary Determinations

A Preliminary Determination provides the Department's conclusion as to whether a proposed change in place of use, point of diversion or appropriation, or character of use of an existing water right should be approved. Changes of water rights may be proposed in an application for transfer (including instream, historic POD, exchange, substitution or ground water registration modification).

The Department has issued preliminary determinations on the transfer applications listed below. In addition to this notice, the Department is complying with ORS 540.520(5) that requires publication of notice in a local newspaper for all transfers except those proposing a change in place of use only or a change in point of diversion of less than ¼ mile where there are no intervening diversion points between the authorized and proposed points of diversion.

Any person may protest the application and preliminary determination or may file a standing statement. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030 and OAR 690-382-0900, protests must raise all reasonably ascertainable issues and include all reasonably available arguments supporting the person's position (see OAR 690-002-0030). In addition, protests must be accompanied by a \$1,425 protest fee for non-applicant and \$720 protest fee for applicant. Call the Protest Coordinator at (503) 507-2749 to obtain additional information. Protests must be received by the Department on or before September 18, 2025 (being 30 days from the date of this notice), or within 30 days of the last date of publication in a newspaper (if required), whichever is later. If no protests are filed, the Department will issue a final order consistent with the preliminary determination.

[T-13626](#) filed by Case Family LLC, 33010 Dever Conner Rd NE, Albany, OR 97321, proposes a modification in point of appropriation and modification in place of use under Registration Application GR-1703 (Certificate of Registration GR-1652). The registration allows the use of a pump well in Sec. 16, T10S, R3W, WM for irrigation in Sec. 16. The applicant proposes to move the point of appropriation to four wells in Sec. 8, T10S, R3W, WM and to change the place of use to Sec. 8, T10S, R3W, WM. The Water Resources Department proposes to approve the modification, based on the requirements of ORS Chapter 540 and OAR 690-382-1000.

[T-13693](#) filed by Case Family LLC, 33010 Dever Conner RD NE, Albany, OR 97321, proposes additional points of appropriation, a modification in place of use, and a modification in character of use under Groundwater Registration GR-2289 (Certificate of Registration GR-2184). The registration allows the use of 177 gallons per minute from Well 4 in Sec. 8, T10S, R3W, W. for irrigation in Sec. 8. The applicant proposes additional points of appropriation in Sec. 8, T10S, R3W, WM, to change the place of use within Sec. 8, T10S, R3W, WM, and to partially change the character of use to agriculture/industrial use. The Water Resources Department proposes to approve the modification, based on the requirements of ORS Chapter 540 and OAR 690-382-1000.

The applicant proposes to change the place of use to Sects. 29 and 32, T5S, R1W, WM.; and to change the character of use of 0.6 acre in Sec. 29, T5S, R1W, WM to nursery use within Sec 29, T 5S, R1W, WM. The Water Resources Department proposes to approve the transfer, based on the requirements of ORS Chapter 540 and OAR 690-380-5000.

The holder of a water right permit may apply to change a point of diversion or appropriation, change the point of diversion to allow the appropriation of groundwater, or change the place of use pursuant to ORS 537.211 (4).
