A) Cont. Ed. Committee Meeting Minutes

B) Other Issues

Jerry Rodgers, OWRD Technical Services Division Administrator, addressed the Cont. Ed. Committee with a proposal to provide a course evaluation form to course sponsors. The evaluation form would be included with course materials. There was a lot of discussion, the main points being whether handing out the evaluation forms would be required or voluntary and workload reviewing the evaluations forms. The Cont. Ed. Committee tabled the proposal until the next meeting where the full Committee is present.

C) Review of Applications

- The Cont. Ed. Committee reviewed the course application for "Water Treatment 101" submitted by United University Water Systems. The instructor is Allen Hurtado, United Pipe & Supply. This seven (7) hour course was held March 19, 2008, in Grants Pass, OR. Daugherty motioned to assign seven (7) CECs, Waldroop seconded. The vote was all in favor.
- The Cont. Ed. Committee reviewed the **revised** information for the course "**Drill Rig** and Compressor Maintenance" submitted by the WSGWA. The instructor is Bruce Mackay, Schramm Inc. The course was part of the **2008 WSGWA Technical Seminar Series, held March 14, 2008, in Tacoma, WA and March 15, 2008, in Kelso, Washington.** Note: The course was originally scheduled for six (6) hours and was reviewed and assigned six (6) CECs at the February 7, 2008, meeting.
