Executive Session: The Cont. Ed. Committee may also convene in a confidential executive session where, by law, only members of the press and Department staff may attend. Others will be asked to leave the room during these discussions, which usually deal with current or potential litigation. Before convening such a session the presiding Cont. Ed. Committee member will make a public announcement and explain necessary procedures.

Public Testimony: The Cont. Ed. Committee encourages public comment on any agenda item. However, public testimony may be limited on items marked with an asterisk (). The asterisk means that the item has already been the subject of a formal public hearing or contested case hearing. On certain items marked with an asterisk, the Cont. Ed. Committee may be authorized to allow public comments. People wishing to speak to the Cont. Ed. Committee are asked to fill out a comment request sheet (available at the meeting). Comments relating to a specific agenda item will be heard by the Cont. Ed. Committee as each agenda item is considered. Comments on other topics may be made during the public comment period at approximately 10:15 a.m.

Every attempt will be made to share with the Cont. Ed. Committee written comments that are delivered to the Department contact in advance of the meeting date. Early delivery of written comments is strongly encouraged so that Cont. Ed. Committee members have sufficient opportunity to review materials prior to the meeting. DIRECTIONS TO THE MEETING

From I-5

Take Exit 256 (Market Street). Heading west on Market, go approximately two miles to Summer Street. Turn left of Summer Street. Go less than ½ mile to our building. Our building is located on your right between the Department of State Lands and the Employment Building.

Parking

Parking is located along Summer Street and also Winter Street (west side of the building). Parking along Summer Street is metered. The parking along Winter Street has a 2-hour limit.

There are six 2-hour parking stalls located between our building and the Employment Building to our south. Parking is also available in the Yellow Lot which is located two blocks south of our building for a fee.
