PUBLIC NOTICE OF WATER USE REQUESTS

This publication lists agency activities requiring public notice. It also describes public comment processes and deadlines. Types of water use requests in this week's Public Notice include:

- * **Permit Application Initial Reviews, Proposed Final Orders, and Final Orders**
Applications for permits to use, store, divert or pump surface water or groundwater. Includes applications by the state Departments of Fish & Wildlife, Environmental Quality or Parks and Recreation for water to be used and kept in-channel.
- * **Expedited Secondary Applications to Use Stored Water**
Applications to use stored water exclusively, filed under a simplified review process.
- * **Applications for Extensions of Time to Perfect Water Right Permits**
New applications received and proposed final orders regarding requests to extend time limits to fully develop water use projects and beneficially apply water.
- * **Applications for Limited Licenses**
Requests to use water for 5 years or less. Licenses are subordinate to other rights and may be revoked if a use is found to injure other water right holders.
- * **Application for Instream Lease**
Application by water right holder to lease existing water rights to instream use.
- * **Transfer Applications: Regular**
Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, or character of use upon which the public may comment. The changes may be proposed in an application for a transfer (including instream or historic POD), an exchange, or a substitution.
- * **Transfer Proposed Final Orders**
Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, and character of use upon which the public may protest the application and Department's proposed final order.

- * **Transfer Applications: Temporary Transfers**
Requests to temporarily change place of use and, if necessary to convey the water to the new place of use, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation.
- * **Transfer Applications: District Permanent for Place of Use - ORS 540.580**
Petitions requesting permanent changes in place(s) of use within a district's boundary.
- * **Ground Water Registration Modifications**
Applications requesting Department recognition of changes in point of appropriation, place of use and character of use under a ground water certificate of registration.
- * **Water Management and Conservation Plan Progress Reports**
Water management and conservation plan progress reports submitted by municipalities under provisions of OAR Chapter 690, Division 86.
- * **Proposed Final Order to Reauthorize HE 576**

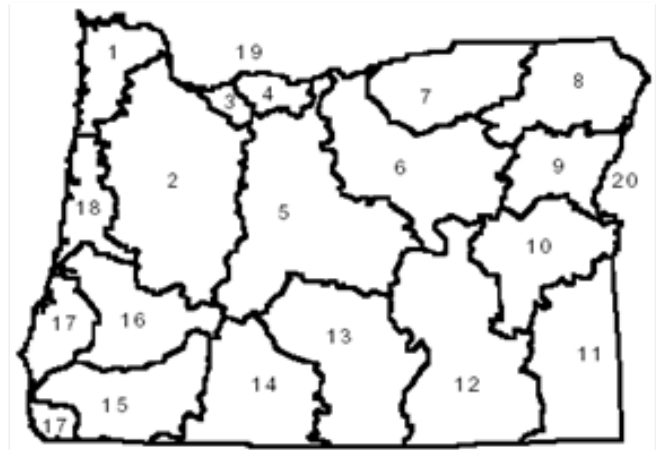

Initial Review and Proposed Final Orders

The following pages of this notice list permit applications that the Department is evaluating for compliance with state water law. Public participation and comment is encouraged. Opportunities for public involvement vary according to the stage of the permit evaluation.

Initial Review (IR) Stage

The Department has given the applicant an initial review of water-use restrictions, water availability and other limitations that affect the agency's decision on whether to issue a permit. The Department welcomes comments from interested persons, agencies and organizations on the proposed water use. **The comment deadline for initial reviews appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Thursday, May 07, 2026.** Although we cannot respond individually to all comments, each will be considered as the agency makes its decision regarding proposed allocations.

Proposed Final Order (PFO) Stage

The proposed final order is the Department's penultimate decision on the water use request. The PFO documents the agency's decision through specific findings, including review of comments received. If appropriate, it includes a draft permit specifying any conditions or restrictions on the use. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$53. (Any person paying \$53 to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued.) PFOs may be viewed free of charge online at: <http://apps.wrd.state.or.us/apps/wr/wrinfo/>. Those disagreeing with the Department's decision as expressed in the PFO have 45 days to file a protest. Detailed information related to filing a protest can be found within the PFO.

The protest deadline for proposed final orders appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Friday, May 22, 2026.

If a protest or comment deadline falls on a day that the office is closed, then the next open business day automatically becomes the deadline date.

Applications for Limited Licenses

A limited license allows the right to use or store water for no more than 5 consecutive years. Use of water under a limited license is subordinate to all other authorized uses and may be shut-off at any time to satisfy those other uses. In addition, the Department may revoke a limited license if its use causes injury to any other water right or minimum perennial streamflow.

Licensees must maintain a record of how much water they are using (ORS 537.143). **The Department may approve a license after April 21, 2026, upon finding that the proposed water use will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest (OAR 690-340-030).** The public is invited to provide comments that will assist the Director in determining whether the use would impair or be detrimental to the public interest. If the applicant applies for a use that is not one of the standard uses listed in OAR 690-300, the Department may, for the purposes of this notice, assign a named use that is reasonably close to the use actually requested. The public may examine the actual application by clicking the associated hyperlink and then choosing "LL Application" under "Scanned Documents."

Applications for Instream Lease

For the term of the lease, the water right holder agrees to suspend use of water under the original right. The state is the trustee for water rights leased for instream use. OAR 690-077-0077 requires that the Department public notice the lease applications.

The deadline for submitting claims of injury to existing water rights or enlargement of the original right against a lease application is April 28, 2026. Parties to the lease, including the Department, will review any such claims before the lease is finalized. An application may involve any of the following changes: Point of diversion or appropriation; Additional point of diversion or appropriation; Historic POD; Place of use; Character of use; Instream; Substitution; or Exchange.

Transfer Proposed Final Order

A Proposed Final Order provides the Department's conclusion as to whether a proposed change in place of use, point of diversion or appropriation, or character of use of an existing water right should be approved. Changes of water rights may be proposed in an application for transfer (including instream, historic POD, exchange, substitution or ground water registration modification).

The Department has issued proposed final orders on the transfer applications listed below. In addition to this notice, the Department is complying with ORS 540.520(5) that requires publication of notice in a local newspaper for all transfers except those proposing a change in place of use only or a change in point of diversion of less than $\frac{1}{4}$ mile where there are no intervening diversion points between the authorized and proposed points of diversion.

Any person may protest a proposed final order to request a contested case hearing on the proposed final order. Protests must meet the requirements of Oregon Laws 2025, chapter 575, section 3a(1), 3a(3)(b), and 3(a)(3)c, including being accompanied by a \$1,425 protest fee for a nonapplicant and \$720 protest fee for an applicant. Protests must be received by the Department on or before May 07, 2026 (being 30 days from the date of this notice). If a protest is filed, any person who supports the proposed final order may file a request for party status to request to participate in any contested case proceeding in support of the proposed final order. Requests for party status must meet the requirements of Oregon Laws 2025, chapter 575, section 3a(2)(b), including being accompanied by \$1,425 request for party status fee. Requests for party status must be received by the Department within 30 days after the deadline for filing a protest. For additional information concerning protests and requests for party status, review the information included in the proposed final order or call the Protest Program Coordinator at (503) 507-2749.

[T-13531](#) filed by Glenn S. Chowning, PO Box 862, Hermiston, OR 97838, proposes additional points of appropriation, and changes in place of use and character of use under Certificate 93290. The right allows the use of 1.23 cubic feet per second from two wells in Sec. 13, T4N, R25E, WM for irrigation in Sec. 13, T4N, R25E, WM. The applicant proposes additional points of appropriation in Sects. 1, 2, 10, and 12, T4N, R25E, WM, to change the place of use to be within the Port of Morrow Service Boundary, and to change the character of use to municipal uses. The Water Resources Department proposes to approve the transfer, based on the requirements of ORS Chapter 540 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Transfer Applications: Temporary Transfer

The holder of a water right subject to transfer may request to temporarily change the place of use of the water for up to 5 years and, if necessary to convey the water, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation. The Department shall approve the request provided it does not cause injury to existing water rights or enlarge the water use. If after the change is approved, it is found to cause injury, the approved change may be revoked. The use of water reverts to the authorized place of use upon expiration of the temporary change.

Transfer Applications: District Permanent for Place of Use - ORS 540.580

A district may request to permanently change the place of use within district boundaries pursuant to ORS 540.580. A petition (application) for a district permanent water right transfer may be submitted subsequent to (specific noticing requirements apply) or prior to the change in place of use, but no later than the end of the calendar year in which the change occurs. The petition may include an unlimited number of place of use transfers within the same petition. Any recently filed Application for District Permanent Water Right Transfer for Place of Use is listed below.

Public comments may be submitted by any person (please follow the instructions on the last page of this public notice). A protest may be filed by any potentially affected holder of an existing water right, either jointly or severally with other persons, provided the protest is not by a user within a district alleging injury to the delivery of water by the district. Each person submitting a protest shall raise all reasonably ascertainable issues and submit all reasonably available arguments supporting the person's position by the close of the protest period. Failure to raise a reasonably ascertainable issue in a protest or failure to provide sufficient specificity to afford the Department an opportunity to respond to the issue precludes consideration of the issue during the hearing. Protests must be accompanied by a \$1425 protest fee for non-applicants and a \$720 protest fee for the applicant, and filed in accordance with OAR Chapter 690, Division 2. **Comments or protests must be received by the Department on or before May 07, 2026.**
