Willamette Basin Reservoir Study

- Cooperative Cost-Share Study (US Army Corps of Engineers & WRD)
- Initiated in 1996
- Stakeholder Participation
- Placed on Hold 2000



Study Purpose

Analyze Water Use in the Basin
Project Future Water Needs
Identify Allocation Options

Study Goals

Authorize Full Range of Uses

- Operational Agreement for Low Flows
- Appropriate Institutional Arrangements
- Modify Water Control Diagrams (Rule Curve)
- Address Irrigation & Municipal Water Demands

Current Tasks

- Implementation of 2008 BiOp
- Small Scale (499 AF) Water Supply Contract Request
- Investigate Action of Pending Reservation Requests
- Investigate Conversion of Minimum Stream Flows
- Coordinate with Integrated Water Resources Strategy

Conclusions

- Study Purpose & Goals still valid today and should be restarted
- US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), WRD, and Stakeholders support restarting the study
- Neither USACE or WRD Budgets include funding
- Study Results Likely to Produce Information Key To:
 - Conversion of Minimum Stream Flows
 - Concluding Reservation Request
 - Oregon's Integrated Water Resources Strategy
