#### PUBLIC NOTICE OF WATER USE REQUESTS February 12, 2013

This publication lists agency activities requiring public notice. It also describes public comment processes and deadlines. Types of water use requests in this week's Public Notice include:

\* **Permit Application Initial Reviews, Proposed Final Orders, and Final Orders** Applications for permits to use, store, divert or pump surface water or groundwater. Includes applications by the state Departments of Fish & Wildlife, Environmental Quality or Parks and Recreation for water to be used and kept in-channel.

#### \* Alternate Reservoir Applications (ORS 537.409)

Applications for storage permits for small ponds filed under a simplified review process.

\* Water Right Cancellations

Abandonment of perfected and developed water rights and requests to cancel all or a portion of rights.

- \* Applications for Extensions of Time to Perfect Water Right Permits New applications received and proposed final orders regarding requests to extend time limits to fully develop water use projects and beneficially apply water.
- \* Extension of Time Checkpoint Progress Reports filed pursuant to OAR 690-315 Documents the progress made toward development of the water use project since approval of the last permit extension and/or the last progress report checkpoint. (OAR 690-315 pertains to permit extension applications filed on or after July 1, 2001.)
- \* **Application for Instream Lease** Application by water right holder to lease existing water rights to instream use.
- \* **Transfer Applications: Regular** Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, or character of use upon which the public may comment. The changes may be proposed in an application for a transfer (including instream or historic POD), an exchange, or a substitution.

#### \* Transfer Preliminary Determinations

Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, and character of use upon which the public may protest the application and Department's preliminary determination.

### \* Transfer Applications: Temporary Transfers

Requests to temporarily change place of use and, if necessary to convey the water to the new place of use, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation.

### \* District Permanent Transfers (ORS 540.580)

Petitions requesting transfers in place of use within a district's boundaries.

#### \* Certificate Issuance

Included in this section is a listing of recently issued water right certificates.

# **Permit Application Initial Reviews and Proposed Final Orders**

The following pages of this notice list permit applications that the Oregon Water Resources Department is evaluating for compliance with state water laws and regulations. Public participation and comment is encouraged. Opportunities for public involvement vary according to the stage of the permit evaluation.

Ground water permit applications in the Deschutes Basin (basin 5) may seek to provide mitigation pursuant to the Deschutes Ground Water Mitigation Rules by implementing a mitigation project or by obtaining mitigation credits made available by a completed mitigation project. Surface water and/or reservoir permit applications in the Deschutes Basin may be proposed ground water mitigation projects.

#### Initial Review Stage (IR in the "Stage" column of the permit listing)

The Department has given the applicant the results of an initial review of water use restrictions, water availability and other limits that affect the agency's decision on whether to issue a permit. The Department welcomes comments from interested persons, agencies and organizations on the proposed water use.

The comment deadline for initial reviews appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Thursday, March 14, 2013. Although we cannot respond individually to all comments, each will be considered as the agency makes its permit decision.

#### **Proposed Final Order Stage (PFO in the "Stage" column of the permit listing)**

The proposed final order is the Department's preliminary decision on the water use request. It will indicate how the comments received on the application in the first stage were considered. The PFO documents the agency's decision through specific findings. If appropriate, it includes a draft permit specifying any conditions or restrictions on the use. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$20. (Any person paying \$20 to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued.) PFO's may be viewed for free at the Department's Salem Office or at the district watermaster office nearest the proposed use. Those disagreeing with the Department's decision as expressed in the PFO have 45 days to file a protest.

# The protest deadline for proposed final orders appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Friday, March 29, 2013.

The protest filing fee is \$300 for the applicants and \$600 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest will be sent with copies of the PFO. Persons who support the PFO may file a "standing" fee of \$150 to retain the ability to participate in future proceedings relating to an application. Before participation is allowed, an additional \$300 will be required at the time of the proceeding.

If a protest or comment deadline falls on a day that the office is closed then the next open business day automatically becomes the deadline date. In addition to the usual state or federal office closures, the Oregon Water Resources Department headquarters office will be closed on the following days: March 23, 2012, May 25, 2012, August 17, 2012, October 19, 2012, November 23, 2012, January 18, 2013, April 19, 2013 and May 24, 2013.

## Alternate Reservoir Applications (ORS 537.409)

For alternate reservoir applications filed under ORS 537.409, the public is invited to comment within 60 days of this notice. The law provides that within 60 days after the Department provides public notice of the application, any person may submit detailed, legally obtained information in writing, requesting the Department to deny the application for a permit on the basis that the reservoir:

- (A) Would result in injury to an existing water right; or
- (B) Would pose a significant detrimental impact to existing fishery resources as determined on the basis of information submitted by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife.

#### Such comments must be submitted on or before April 13, 2013.

## Water Right Cancellations

ORS 540.621 authorizes the Director to issue an order canceling a perfected and developed water right whenever the owner certifies under oath that the right has been abandoned and requests a cancellation of the right.

The Department has received affidavits from owners of land to which a water right is appurtenant stating the owner has abandoned the water right, and requesting that the Department cancel portions of the right appurtenant to the land.

## Proposed Final Orders Regarding Applications for Extensions of Time for Water Right Permits

ORS 537.230, 537.248, 537.630 and 539.010 authorize the Water Resources Department to extend time limits contained in water right permits for completing construction of water development projects and applying water to full beneficial use. Procedures for permit holders to apply for extensions and for the Department to evaluate and determine whether or not to approve extensions of time are contained in OAR 690-320-0010 for extensions filed before July 1, 2001, and in OAR 690-315-0010 for extensions filed on or after July 1, 2001.

Proposed Final Orders (PFO's) are the Department's preliminary decision on extension requests. They document the agency's decision through specific findings. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$20. (Any person paying to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued). PFO's may be viewed for free at the Department's Salem Office or at the appropriate district watermaster office.

#### **Extension of Time Public Notice and Comment Procedures**

Written comments on or written protests against a PFO must be submitted on or before March **29, 2013.** There is no fee for submission of comments. The protest filing fee is \$300 for the applicant and \$600 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest will be sent with copies of the PFO.

OAR 690-077-0077 requires that the Department public notice the lease applications.

The deadline for submitting claims of injury to existing water rights or enlargement of the original right against a lease application is March 05, 2013. Parties to the lease, including the Department, will review any such claims before the lease is finalized. # **Transfer Preliminary Determinations**

A Preliminary Determination provides the Department's conclusion as to whether a proposed change in place of use, point of diversion or appropriation, or character of use of an existing water right should be approved. Changes of water rights may be proposed in an application for transfer (including instream, historic POD, exchange, substitution or ground water registration modification).

The Department has issued preliminary determinations on the transfer applications listed below. In addition to this notice, the Department is complying with ORS 540.520(2) that requires publication of notice in a local newspaper for all transfers except those proposing a change in place of use only or a change in point of diversion of less than <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> mile where there are no intervening diversion points.

Any person may protest the application and preliminary determination or may file a standing statement. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030(3) and OAR 690-382-0900, protests must raise all reasonably ascertainable issues and include all reasonably available arguments supporting the person's position. In addition, protests must be accompanied by a \$600 protest fee for non-applicant and \$300.00 protest fee for applicant. A Water Right Transfer Protest Form is available at http://www.oregon.gov/OWRD/PUBS/forms.shtml or by calling 503-986-0888. Protests must be received by the Department on or before March 14, 2013, or within 30 days of the last date of publication in a newspaper, whichever is later. If no protests are filed, the Department will issue a final order consistent with the preliminary determination.

T-11159 filed by Mark Zoller of Willow Farms, LLC, PO Box 288, Washougal, WA 98671, proposes to change the places of use for portions of eight water rights. Certificates 53377, 53379, 75806 and 76583 allow use of 0.89 cfs from diversions on Willow Creek in Sec. 7 and 20, T2N, R23E, W.M. Certificates 83339, 83340 and 83341 allow use of 0.25 cfs from wells in Sec. 17 and 20. Certificate 83342 allows use of 299 gallons per minute from wells in Sec. 8, 17 and 20. The applicant proposes to change the places of use for primary and supplemental irrigation for all the above described rights from Sec. 8, 16, 17, 18, 20 and 21 to other locations within Sec. 7, 17, 18 and 19. The Water Resources Department proposes to approve the transfer, based on the requirements of ORS Chapter 540 and OAR 690-380-5000.

T-11279 filed by Gregory Bulkley and Jacqueline Graham, 28850 Ivory Pine Rd, PO Box 46, Bly, OR 97622, proposes changes in place of use and character of use under Certificates 45158, 47296 and 68022. The rights allow the use of 2.39 cubic feet per second (cfs) from Fivemile Creek in Sec. 1 and 2, T36S, R13E, W.M. for irrigation in Sec. 1 and 2. The applicants propose to create an instream use in Five Mile Creek from the points of diversion to the mouth at a maximum of 1.87 cfs. The Water Resources Department proposes to approve the transfer, based on the requirements of ORS Chapter 540, OAR 690-380-5000 and OAR 690-077-0075. T-11458 filed by City Of Redmond (243 East Antler Ave, Redmond, OR 97756) and Central Oregon Irrigation District (1055 SW Lake Court, Redmond, OR 97756), proposes a change in place of use and character of use under Certificate 83571. The right allows the use of up to 20.203 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND from the DESCHUTES RIVER at the North Canal Dam Diversion #11 in Sec. 29, T 17S, R 12E, W.M. for municipal use. The applicant proposes to create an instream use in the Deschutes River (from the COID North Canal Dam to Lake Billy Chinook). The Water Resources Department proposes to approve the transfer, based on the requirements of ORS Chapter 540, OAR 690-380-5000, and OAR 690-077-0075. The applicants also propose cancellation of a portion of Certificate 76714. The Department has also concluded that the proposed transfer appears to result in mitigation for Groundwater Permit Application G-14905 pursuant to OAR 690-505-0500 & OAR 690-505-0630.

# **Transfer Applications: Temporary Transfer**

The holder of a water right subject to transfer may request to temporarily change the place of use of the water for up to 5 years and, if necessary to convey the water, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation. The Department shall approve the request provided it does not cause injury to existing water rights or expand the water use. If after the change is approved, it is found to cause injury, the approved change may be revoked. The use of water reverts to the authorized place of use upon expiration of the temporary change.

# **District Permanent Transfers (ORS 540.580)**

A district may request to permanently change the place of use within district boundaries. A district may provide notice to the Department of a change before it is made, and shall submit a district permanent application prior to the end of the calendar year in which the change occurs. The Department shall approve the transfer application provided it does not cause injury to existing water rights or expand the water use. The final order approving the permanent transfer is subject to protest.

This public notice also includes district notices of proposed changes. The Department will accept comments on injury and enlargement of changes in place of use associated with the notice and use those comments in the review of the proposed change.

The Department seeks public comment on recently filed district transfer applications listed below. The deadline for comments or protests to the transfer application must be received by the Department on or before March 14, 2013. The Department will hold a contested case hearing if: 1) a protest and \$600 protest fee for non-applicant and \$300.00 protest fee for applicant are received within the time allowed; or 2) the Department finds a hearing is needed to determine whether the proposed changes would result in injury to existing rights. (If a water user believes that a proposed change could injure a water delivery within a district's boundaries, the matter will be resolved directly between the district and the water user.)
