



- ➤ District 8- Total Area = 3,254 Square Miles
 - Major Counties- Baker and the portion of Union County within the North Powder River and Wolf Creek drainages
 - The office is located at the Baker County Courthouse in Baker City
 - Baker and Union Counties provide Long Standing funding for two full time and one seasonal Deputy Watermaster

- Primary Water Rights- 3521 covering 229,420 acres
 - Surface Water 2861 Water Rights / 218,631 acres
 - Groundwater 226 Water Rights /10,788 acres
 - Storage 450 Water Rights
- Supplemental Water Rights- 585 covering 154,748 acres
 - Surface Water 350 Water Rights / 115,712 acres
 - Groundwater 219 Water Rights / 39,036 acres



Regulation




- Regulation is to protect senior out of stream water rights
 - 2012 distributed on 37 streams and 1415 regulations
- > Heavily Distributed stream systems in Dist. 8 are:
 - Pine and East Pine Creeks, Clear Creek in the Halfway area
 - Eagle Creek in the Richland area
 - Rock Creek near Haines
 - Pine Creek, Mill Creek, Marble Creek in the West Hills of Baker area
 - North Powder River and stored water from Pilcher Creek Reservoir




North Powder River / Pilcher Creek Reservoir Distribution











