

Session Basics

During odd numbered years,

- Legislative Assembly convenes on second Monday in January
- Session, including hearings, begins in February
- May not exceed 160 days, without an extension
- Intent to adjourn Sine Die by June 28

Session Basics

Timeline for Policy and Budget Bills:

- April 8
 - Deadline for Chairs to schedule Work Sessions for Measures in First Chamber
- April 18
 - Deadline for Committees to hold Work Sessions for Measure in First Chamber
- May 20
 - Deadline for Chairs to schedule Work Sessions for Measures in Second Chamber
- May 31
 - Deadline for Committees to <u>hold</u> Work Sessions for Measures in Second Chamber

SB 5547

Appropriates money from the General Fund to the Department

SB 5506

General obligation bonds, revenue bonds, certificates of participation, other financing programs. Includes loans to the Umatilla Basin

Water-Related Bills

Other Water-Related Bills

- Several focused on development of in-conduit hydro projects
- A required environmental review for water right transfers
- A request to recapitalize the Deschutes Mitigation Bank
- Remove WRD from wave energy permitting
- Designation of additional state scenic waterways
- Additional restrictions on placer mining/suction dredging
