2014 LEGISLATION ENACTED



House Bill 4045

Reinstates the Groundwater Continuing Education Program.

House Bill 4015

Requires Department to deliver a plan to the Governor describing participation in regional solutions teams.



BILLS THAT DIED IN COMMITTEE



Senate Bill 1512

Would have allowed the temporary transfer or lease of determined water right claims in the Klamath Basin Adjudication.

House Bill 4044 and 4064, and Senate Bill 1572 Would have placed additional requirements and restrictions on the Department in order to deny, condition, limit or restrict a new groundwater right, or to regulate a well for a senior surface water determined claim.
