Budget Update Overview

- 2013-15 Statewide Reductions in General Fund
 - 2% Holdback = \$540,096
 - 5% Administrative Reduction = \$124,978
- Revenue Forecast update
- 2015-17 Budget Development

- 2% Statewide Reduction
 - \$540,096 asked to be restored
 - Without funds, Department would slow recruitments
 - Early indications are that \$135,000 will be added back into the budget

- 5% Administrative Reduction
- Purpose was to drive statewide efficiencies
 - Enacted sooner that statewide enterprise savings could be generated
 - Individual agencies now required to attain target
- WRD is reducing administrative budget for travel, postage, supplies, staff salaries
 - \$124,978 General Fund
 - \$67,695 Other Funds
