Grant Program

- The Water Conservation, Reuse and Storage Grant Program was established by Senate Bill 1069 (2008).
- Designed to fund qualifying costs of planning studies that evaluate the feasibility of developing water conservation, reuse or storage projects.
- 2.4 Million Awarded since 2008
- 39 Studies Completed








