PUBLIC NOTICE OF WATER USE REQUESTS April 29, 2014

This publication lists agency activities requiring public notice. It also describes public comment processes and deadlines. Types of water use requests in this week's Public Notice include:

- * **Permit Application Initial Reviews, Proposed Final Orders, and Final Orders** Applications for permits to use, store, divert or pump surface water or groundwater. Includes applications by the state Departments of Fish & Wildlife, Environmental Quality or Parks and Recreation for water to be used and kept in-channel.
- * Alternate Reservoir Applications (ORS 537.409) Applications for storage permits for small ponds filed under a simplified review process.
- * **Expedited Secondary Applications to Use Stored Water** Applications to use stored water exclusively, filed under a simplified review process.
- * Emergency Water Use Permit Applications
 Final Orders issued approving applications for temporary water use permits during a drought declared under ORS 536.740.
- * Applications for Limited Licenses Requests to use water for 5 years or less. Licenses are subordinate to other rights and may be revoked if a use is found to injure other water right holders.
- * **Application for Instream Lease** Application by water right holder to lease existing water rights to instream use.
- * Establishment of Mitigation Credits in the Deschutes Basin pursuant to OAR Chapter 690, Division 521 (ORS 537.746)
- * **Transfer Applications: Regular** Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, or character of use upon which the public may comment. The changes may be proposed in an application for a transfer (including instream or historic POD), an exchange, or a substitution.
 - **Transfer Applications: Temporary Transfers** Requests to temporarily change place of use and, if necessary to convey the water to the new place of use, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation.

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* Transfer Applications: Drought Temporary Transfers

Requests to temporarily change character of use, place of use or point of diversion during a drought declared under ORS 536.740.

* **District Temporary Transfers (ORS 540.570)** Applications requesting transfers in place of use within a district's boundaries.

* Certificate Issuance

Included in this section is a listing of recently issued water right certificates.

Permit Application Initial Reviews and Proposed Final Orders

The following pages of this notice list permit applications that the Oregon Water Resources Department is evaluating for compliance with state water laws and regulations. Public participation and comment is encouraged. Opportunities for public involvement vary according to the stage of the permit evaluation.

Ground water permit applications in the Deschutes Basin (basin 5) may seek to provide mitigation pursuant to the Deschutes Ground Water Mitigation Rules by implementing a mitigation project or by obtaining mitigation credits made available by a completed mitigation project. Surface water and/or reservoir permit applications in the Deschutes Basin may be proposed ground water mitigation projects.

Initial Review Stage (IR in the "Stage" column of the permit listing)

The Department has given the applicant the results of an initial review of water use restrictions, water availability and other limits that affect the agency's decision on whether to issue a permit. The Department welcomes comments from interested persons, agencies and organizations on the proposed water use.

The comment deadline for initial reviews appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Thursday, May 29, 2014. Although we cannot respond individually to all comments, each will be considered as the agency makes its permit decision.

Proposed Final Order Stage (PFO in the "Stage" column of the permit listing)

The proposed final order is the Department's preliminary decision on the water use request. It will indicate how the comments received on the application in the first stage were considered. The PFO documents the agency's decision through specific findings. If appropriate, it includes a draft permit specifying any conditions or restrictions on the use. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$25. (Any person paying \$25 to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued.) PFO's may be viewed for free at the Department's Salem Office or at the district watermaster office nearest the proposed use. Those disagreeing with the Department's decision as expressed in the PFO have 45 days to file a protest.

The protest deadline for proposed final orders appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Friday, June 13, 2014.

The protest filing fee is \$350 for the applicants and \$700 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest will be sent with copies of the PFO. Persons who support the PFO may file a "standing" fee of \$200 to retain the ability to participate in future proceedings relating to an application. Before participation is allowed, an additional \$500 will be required at the time of the proceeding.

If a protest or comment deadline falls on a day that the office is closed then the next open business day automatically becomes the deadline date.

Alternate Reservoir Applications (ORS 537.409)

For alternate reservoir applications filed under ORS 537.409, the public is invited to comment within 60 days of this notice. The law provides that within 60 days after the Department provides public notice of the application, any person may submit detailed, legally obtained information in writing, requesting the Department to deny the application for a permit on the basis that the reservoir:

- (A) Would result in injury to an existing water right; or
- (B) Would pose a significant detrimental impact to existing fishery resources as determined on the basis of information submitted by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife.

Such comments must be submitted on or before June 28, 2014.

Expedited Secondary Applications Under HB 2178 (2005)

Emergency Water Use Permit Applications

Under OAR 690-19-040, after the Governor declares that a severe, continuing drought exists, the Director may accept applications for emergency use permits.

The Director shall approve an application for emergency water use upon findings that the proposed use will not cause injury to existing water rights and will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest. In evaluating whether the proposed use will impair or be detrimental to the public interest, the Director shall consider the factors described in OAR 690-310-0120 and 690-310-0130; and

- a) The need for water because of the drought emergency; and
- b) The short-term nature of the proposed emergency use.

An emergency use permit may be issued upon approval by the Director. No hearing under ORS 537.170 is required. The Director will consider all comments received concerning the use, or proposed use, under the emergency use permit throughout the life of the permit. Use of water under a emergency use permit may be regulated at any time in accordance with the terms and conditions of the permit. If use of water under a emergency use permit causes injury to an existing water right, the permit shall be revoked unless the injury is mitigated to the satisfaction of the injured water right holder. Any use of water under an emergency use permit shall not exceed the term of the Governor's declared drought or one year.

Applications for Extensions of Time for Water Right Permits

ORS 537.230, 537.248, 537.630 and 539.010 authorize the Water Resources Department to extend time limits contained in water right permits for completing construction of water development projects and applying water to full beneficial use. Procedures for permit holders to apply for extensions and for the Department to evaluate and determine whether or not to approve extensions of time are contained in OAR 690-320-0010 for extensions filed before July 1, 2001, and in OAR 690-315-0010 for extensions filed on or after July 1, 2001.

Proposed Final Orders (PFO's) are the Department's preliminary decision on extension requests. They document the agency's decision through specific findings. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$25. (Any person paying to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued). PFO's may be viewed for free at the Department's Salem Office or at the appropriate district watermaster office.

Extension of Time Public Notice and Comment Procedures

Written comments on or written protests against a PFO must be submitted on or before June 13, 2014. There is no fee for submission of comments. The protest filing fee is \$350 for the applicant and \$700 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest will be sent with copies of the PFO.

Applications for Limited Licenses

A limited license allows the right to use or store water for no more than 5 consecutive years. Use of water under a limited license is subordinate to all other authorized uses and may be shut-off at any time to satisfy those other uses. In addition, the Department may revoke a limited license if its use causes injury to any other water right or minimum perennial streamflow.

Licensees must maintain a record of how much water they are using (ORS 537.143). **The Department** may approve a license after May 13, 2014, upon finding that the proposed water use will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest (OAR 690-340-030). The public is invited to provide comments that will assist the Director in determining whether the use would impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

For the term of the lease, the water right holder agrees to suspend use of water under the original right. The state is the trustee for water rights leased for instream use. OAR 690-077-0077 requires that the Department public notice the lease applications.

The deadline for submitting claims of injury to existing water rights or enlargement of the original right against a lease application is May 20, 2014. Parties to the lease, including the Department, will review any such claims before the lease is finalized. The lease files are available for viewing at the Salem office of the Water Resources Department.
