This publication lists agency activities requiring public notice. It also describes public comment processes and deadlines. Types of water use requests in this week's Public Notice include:

- * Permit Application Initial Reviews, Proposed Final Orders, and Final Orders
 Applications for permits to use, store, divert or pump surface water or groundwater. Includes applications by the state Departments of Fish & Wildlife, Environmental Quality or Parks and Recreation for water to be used and kept in-channel.

 Applications for storage permits for small ponds filed under a simplified review process.
- * Applications for Extensions of Time to Perfect Water Right Permits

 Requests to temporarily change place of use and, if necessary to convey the water to the new place of use, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation.
- * Transfer Applications: Drought Temporary Transfers
 Requests to temporarily change character of use, place of use or point of diversion during a drought declared under ORS 536.740.
- * Transfer Applications: Permit Amendments Requests to amend permits.

* Transfer Applications: Regular

Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, or character of use upon which the public may comment. The changes may be proposed in an application for a transfer (including instream or historic POD), an exchange, or a substitution.

* Recommendation to Consent to Injury

A recommendation from the agency that requested establishment of an instream water right for the Department to consent to injury of the instream water right resulting from a transfer.

* Certificate Issuance

Included in this section is a listing of recently issued water right certificates.

Permit Application Initial Reviews and Proposed Final Orders

The following pages of this notice list permit applications that the Oregon Water Resources Department is evaluating for compliance with state water laws and regulations. Public participation and comment is encouraged. Opportunities for public involvement vary according to the stage of the permit evaluation.

Ground water permit applications in the Deschutes Basin (basin 5) may seek to provide mitigation pursuant to the Deschutes Ground Water Mitigation Rules by implementing a mitigation project or by obtaining mitigation credits made available by a completed mitigation project. Surface water and/or reservoir permit applications in the Deschutes Basin may be proposed ground water mitigation projects.

Initial Review Stage (IR in the "Stage" column of the permit listing)

The Department has given the applicant the results of an initial review of water use restrictions, water availability and other limits that affect the agency's decision on whether to issue a permit. The Department welcomes comments from interested persons, agencies and organizations on the proposed water use.

The comment deadline for initial reviews appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Thursday, July 10, 2014. Although we cannot respond individually to all comments, each will be considered as the agency makes its permit decision.

Proposed Final Order Stage (PFO in the "Stage" column of the permit listing)

The proposed final order is the Department's preliminary decision on the water use request. It will indicate how the comments received on the application in the first stage were considered. The PFO documents the agency's decision through specific findings. If appropriate, it includes a draft permit specifying any conditions or restrictions on the use. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$25. (Any person paying \$25 to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued.) PFO's may be viewed for free at the Department's Salem Office or at the district watermaster office nearest the proposed use. Those disagreeing with the Department's decision as expressed in the PFO have 45 days to file a protest.

The protest deadline for proposed final orders appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Friday, July 25, 2014.

The protest filing fee is \$350 for the applicants and \$700 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest will be sent with copies of the PFO. Persons who support the PFO may file a "standing" fee of \$200 to retain the ability to participate in future proceedings relating to an application. Before participation is allowed, an additional \$500 will be required at the time of the proceeding.

If a protest or comment deadline falls on a day that the office is closed then the next open business day automatically becomes the deadline date.



Alternate Reservoir Applications (ORS 537.409)

For alternate reservoir applications filed under ORS 537.409, the public is invited to comment within 60 days of this notice. The law provides that within 60 days after the Department provides public notice of the application, any person may submit detailed, legally obtained information in writing, requesting the Department to deny the application for a permit on the basis that the reservoir:

- (A) Would result in injury to an existing water right; or
- (B) Would pose a significant detrimental impact to existing fishery resources as determined on the basis of information submitted by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife.

Proposed Final Orders Regarding Applications for Extensions of Time for Water Right Permits

ORS 537.230, 537.248, 537.630 and 539.010 authorize the Water Resources Department to extend time limits contained in water right permits for completing construction of water development projects and applying water to full beneficial use. Procedures for permit holders to apply for extensions and for the Department to evaluate and determine whether or not to approve extensions of time are contained in OAR 690-320-0010 for extensions filed before July 1, 2001, and in OAR 690-315-0010 for extensions filed on or after July 1, 2001.

Proposed Final Orders (PFO's) are the Department's preliminary decision on extension requests. They document the agency's decision through specific findings. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$25. (Any person paying to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued). PFO's may be viewed for free at the Department's Salem Office or at the appropriate district watermaster office.

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Applications for Instream Lease

ORS 537.348 authorizes a water right holder to lease their existing water right(s) to instream use for a limited time. For the term of the lease, the water right holder agrees to suspend use of water under the original right. The state is the trustee for water rights leased for instream use. OAR 690-077-0077 requires that the Department public notice the lease applications.

The deadline for submitting claims of injury to existing water rights or enlargement of the original right against a lease application is July 01, 2014. Parties to the lease, including the Department, will review any such claims before the lease is finalized. Transfer Preliminary Determinations

A Preliminary Determination provides the Department's conclusion as to whether a proposed change in place of use, point of diversion or appropriation, or character of use of an existing water right should be approved. Changes of water rights may be proposed in an application for transfer (including instream, historic POD, exchange, substitution or ground water registration modification).

The Department has issued preliminary determinations on the transfer applications listed below. In addition to this notice, the Department is complying with ORS 540.520(2) that requires publication of notice in a local newspaper for all transfers except those proposing a change in place of use only or a change in point of diversion of less than ½ mile where there are no intervening diversion points.

Any person may protest the application and preliminary determination or may file a standing statement. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030(3) and OAR 690-382-0900, protests must raise all reasonably ascertainable issues and include all reasonably available arguments supporting the person's position. In addition, protests must be accompanied by a \$700 protest fee for non-applicant and \$350.00 protest fee for applicant. A Water Right Transfer Protest Form is available at http://www.oregon.gov/OWRD/PUBS/forms.shtml or by calling 503-986-0888. Protests must be received by the Department on or before July 10, 2014, or within 30 days of the last date of publication in a newspaper, whichever is later. If no protests are filed, the Department will issue a final order consistent with the preliminary determination.

T-11661 filed by Lonerock Ranch Inc., 26733 Campbell Lane, Condon, OR 97823, proposes a place of use change under Certificate 25357. The right allows the use of 1/40 cfs per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cfs per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acrefeet per acre during season April 1 to September 30 from Lone Rock Creek and a spring in Sec. 8, T6S, R24E, WM for irrigation, domestic and stock in Sec. 5. The applicant proposes to change the place of use to Sections 4 and 5. The Water Resources Department proposes to approve the transfer, based on the requirements of ORS Chapter 540 and OAR 690-380-5000.

T-11671 filed by Travis Singhose, 29327 Weaver Springs Lane, Burns, OR 97720, proposes a point of appropriation change under Certificate 72361. The right allows the use of 1.18 cfs from Well 1 in Sec. 27, T25S, R30E, WM for irrigation in Sec. 26. The applicant proposes to move the point of appropriation to Sec. 26, T25S, R30E, WM. The Water Resources Department proposes to approve the transfer, based on the requirements of ORS Chapter 540 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Transfer Applications: Temporary Transfer

The holder of a water right subject to transfer may request to temporarily change the place of use of the water for up to 5 years and, if necessary to convey the water, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation. The Department shall approve the request provided it does not cause injury to existing water rights or expand the water use. If after the change is approved, it is found to cause injury, the approved change may be revoked. The use of water reverts to the authorized place of use upon expiration of the temporary change.

During the effective time period of a drought declaration under ORS 536.740, the Commission or the Director may: (1) Allow a temporary transfer of a water right without complying with the notice and waiting requirements of ORS 540.520; (2) Allow a temporary exchange of water without giving notice as required under ORS 540.535; and (3) Use an expedited notice and waiting requirement for the substitution of a supplemental ground water right for a primary water right.

Notice is given that the following applications for Drought Temporary Transfers have been received by the Department. Consistent with the drought emergency, an order approving or denying the drought transfer will be issued as soon as the Department is able to process the application.

The Department determined that the transfer would injure instream water right Certificate 59537. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) concluded that the transfer would result in net benefits to the resource due to the replacement and removal of three push-up dams, thereby allowing all life stages of fish to have passage at all stream flows at the dam locations throughout the year and improvement of fish habitat due to the reduction of streambed disturbance caused by annual dam construction. ODFW recommended the following condition: Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install an approved fish screen at the new point of diversion and shall provide to the OWRD a written statement from Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) that the installed screen meets the state's criteria, or that ODFW has determined a screen is not necessary. The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.
