PUBLIC NOTICE OF WATER USE REQUESTS July 8, 2014

This publication lists agency activities requiring public notice. It also describes public comment processes and deadlines. Types of water use requests in this week's Public Notice include:

- * **Permit Application Initial Reviews, Proposed Final Orders, and Final Orders** Applications for permits to use, store, divert or pump surface water or groundwater. Includes applications by the state Departments of Fish & Wildlife, Environmental Quality or Parks and Recreation for water to be used and kept in-channel.
- * **Expedited Secondary Applications to Use Stored Water** Applications to use stored water exclusively, filed under a simplified review process.
- * **Emergency Water Use Permit Applications** Final Orders issued approving applications for temporary water use permits during a drought declared under ORS 536.740.
- * Applications for Extensions of Time to Perfect Water Right Permits New applications received and proposed final orders regarding requests to extend time limits to fully develop water use projects and beneficially apply water.
- * **Application for Instream Lease** Application by water right holder to lease existing water rights to instream use.
- * Establishment of Mitigation Credits in the Deschutes Basin pursuant to OAR Chapter 690, Division 521 (ORS 537.746)
 - **Transfer Applications: Regular** Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, or character of use upon which the public may comment. The changes may be proposed in an application for a transfer (including instream or historic POD), an exchange, or a substitution.
- * **Transfer Preliminary Determinations** Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, and character of use upon which the public may protest the application and Department's preliminary determination.
- * **Transfer Applications: Temporary Transfers** Requests to temporarily change place of use and, if necessary to convey the water to the new place of use, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation.
- * **Transfer Applications: Permit Amendments** Requests to amend permits.

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* Ground Water Registration Modifications

Applications requesting Department recognition of changes in point of appropriation, place of use and character of use under a ground water certificate of registration.

* Certificate Issuance Included in this section is a listing of recently issued water right certificates.

Permit Application Initial Reviews and Proposed Final Orders

The following pages of this notice list permit applications that the Oregon Water Resources Department is evaluating for compliance with state water laws and regulations. Public participation and comment is encouraged. Opportunities for public involvement vary according to the stage of the permit evaluation.

Ground water permit applications in the Deschutes Basin (basin 5) may seek to provide mitigation pursuant to the Deschutes Ground Water Mitigation Rules by implementing a mitigation project or by obtaining mitigation credits made available by a completed mitigation project. Surface water and/or reservoir permit applications in the Deschutes Basin may be proposed ground water mitigation projects.

Initial Review Stage (IR in the "Stage" column of the permit listing)

The Department has given the applicant the results of an initial review of water use restrictions, water availability and other limits that affect the agency's decision on whether to issue a permit. The Department welcomes comments from interested persons, agencies and organizations on the proposed water use.

The comment deadline for initial reviews appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Thursday, August 07, 2014. Although we cannot respond individually to all comments, each will be considered as the agency makes its permit decision.

Proposed Final Order Stage (PFO in the "Stage" column of the permit listing)

The proposed final order is the Department's preliminary decision on the water use request. It will indicate how the comments received on the application in the first stage were considered. The PFO documents the agency's decision through specific findings. If appropriate, it includes a draft permit specifying any conditions or restrictions on the use. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$25. (Any person paying \$25 to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued.) PFO's may be viewed for free at the Department's Salem Office or at the district watermaster office nearest the proposed use. Those disagreeing with the Department's decision as expressed in the PFO have 45 days to file a protest.

The protest deadline for proposed final orders appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Friday, August 22, 2014.

The protest filing fee is \$350 for the applicants and \$700 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest will be sent with copies of the PFO. Persons who support the PFO may file a "standing" fee of \$200 to retain the ability to participate in future proceedings relating to an application. Before participation is allowed, an additional \$500 will be required at the time of the proceeding.

If a protest or comment deadline falls on a day that the office is closed then the next open business day automatically becomes the deadline date.

If public interest issues are raised, the Department may move the application to the standard process and review the application pursuant to ORS 537.153, and issue a Proposed Final Order. If no public issues are raised, the Department may issue a final order and permit without further prior notice.

Comments must identify the specific public interest under ORS 537.170(8) that would be impaired or detrimentally affected by the proposed use, and specifically how the identified public interest would be affected.

Emergency Water Use Permit Applications

Under OAR 690-19-040, after the Governor declares that a severe, continuing drought exists, the Director may accept applications for emergency use permits.

The Director shall approve an application for emergency water use upon findings that the proposed use will not cause injury to existing water rights and will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest. In evaluating whether the proposed use will impair or be detrimental to the public interest, the Director shall consider the factors described in OAR 690-310-0120 and 690-310-0130; and

- a
- a) The need for water because of the drought emergency; and
- b) The short-term nature of the proposed emergency use.

An emergency use permit may be issued upon approval by the Director. No hearing under ORS 537.170 is required. The Director will consider all comments received concerning the use, or proposed use, under the emergency use permit throughout the life of the permit. Use of water under a emergency use permit may be regulated at any time in accordance with the terms and conditions of the permit. If use of water under a emergency use permit causes injury to an existing water right, the permit shall be revoked unless the injury is mitigated to the satisfaction of the injured water right holder. Any use of water under an emergency use permit shall not exceed the term of the Governor's declared drought or one year.

Applications for Extensions of Time for Water Right Permits

ORS 537.230, 537.248, 537.630 and 539.010 authorize the Water Resources Department to extend time limits contained in water right permits for completing construction of water development projects and applying water to full beneficial use. Procedures for permit holders to apply for extensions and for the Department to evaluate and determine whether or not to approve extensions of time are contained in OAR 690-320-0010 for extensions filed before July 1, 2001, and in OAR 690-315-0010 for extensions filed on or after July 1, 2001.

Proposed Final Orders (PFO's) are the Department's preliminary decision on extension requests. They document the agency's decision through specific findings. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$25. (Any person paying to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued). PFO's may be viewed for free at the Department's Salem Office or at the appropriate district watermaster office.

Extension of Time Public Notice and Comment Procedures

Written comments on or written protests against a PFO must be submitted on or before August 22, 2014. There is no fee for submission of comments. The protest filing fee is \$350 for the applicant and \$700 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest will be sent with copies of the PFO.

Establishment of Mitigation Credits in the Deschutes Basin

ORS 537.746 authorizes the Department to award mitigation credits in the Deschutes Basin to approved mitigation projects. Mitigation credits may be used in the Deschutes Basin, specifically the Deschutes Ground Water Study Area, to mitigate for the impacts of ground water use on surface water flows. Pursuant to OAR Chapter 690, Division 521, upon receipt of notification of a mitigation project, the Department shall give public notice of the intent to establish mitigation credits.

The public is invited to comment on establishment of mitigation credits for the project(s) described below. Comments must be received within 21 days of the date of this public notice. Comments should address the award of mitigation credits to the proposed project and its use for mitigation purposes. Included in this public notice is a preliminary determination as to the amount of mitigation credits that may be available from the proposed project.

Transfer Preliminary Determinations

A Preliminary Determination provides the Department's conclusion as to whether a proposed change in place of use, point of diversion or appropriation, or character of use of an existing water right should be approved. Changes of water rights may be proposed in an application for transfer (including instream, historic POD, exchange, substitution or ground water registration modification).

The Department has issued preliminary determinations on the transfer applications listed below. In addition to this notice, the Department is complying with ORS 540.520(2) that requires publication of notice in a local newspaper for all transfers except those proposing a change in place of use only or a change in point of diversion of less than ¹/₄ mile where there are no intervening diversion points.

Any person may protest the application and preliminary determination or may file a standing statement. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030(3) and OAR 690-382-0900, protests must raise all reasonably ascertainable issues and include all reasonably available arguments supporting the person's position. In addition, protests must be accompanied by a \$700 protest fee for non-applicant and \$350.00 protest fee for applicant. A Water Right Transfer Protest Form is available at http://www.oregon.gov/OWRD/PUBS/forms.shtml or by calling 503-986-0888. Protests must be received by the Department on or before August 07, 2014, or within 30 days of the last date of publication in a newspaper, whichever is later. If no protests are filed, the Department will issue a final order consistent with the preliminary determination.

T-10990 filed by City of Beaverton, 4755 SW Griffith Dr., Beaverton, OR. 97076, proposes additional points of appropriation and a place of use change under GR-343. The registration allows the use of 3.008 cfs from two wells in Sects. 11 and 21, T1S, R1W, WM for municipal use. The applicant proposes additional points of appropriation in Sects. 20, 21, 28, and 30, T1S, R1W, WM and Sec. 5, T2S, R1W, WM and to change the place of use to reflect the current service area. The Water Resources Department proposes to approve the modification, based on the requirements of ORS Chapter 540 and OAR 690-380-5000.

T-11711 filed by Ken and Bambi Fletcher, 13290 Buena Vista Rd, Independence, OR 97351, proposes to change the point of diversion under Certificate 42036.
