Grant Program Background


- The Water Conservation, Reuse & Storage Grant Program was established in 2008 by Senate Bill 1069.
- Designed to fund qualifying cost of planning studies that evaluate the feasibility of developing water conservation, reuse or storage projects.
- \$3 Million Awarded since 2008
- 39 Studies Completed

Current Biennium: 2013-15


- First grant cycle August November 2013
- Awarded \$593,660 funding at Commission's February meeting
- Commission approved second grant cycle
- Solicited for applications through April 11th

2014 Grant Cycle


- Approximately \$590,000 funds requested

Types of Projects




