

Grants Pass Geology Workshop
May 17-18, 2006
Grants Pass, Oregon

This workshop will discuss local geology and its affects on water resources, landforms, forest health, soils, land use, and mineral resources. On Wednesday morning, a series of presentations in Grants Pass will provide an overview based on recent geologic mapping including subsurface studies using well data. That afternoon there will be a half-day field trip near Grants Pass. On Thursday, May 18th, there will be a daylong field trip looking at the geology between Grants Pass and Central Point. Field trips will visit exposures of geologic units in the area. The appearance of common lithologies in outcrop will be discussed relative to their appearance in well cuttings.
