
Request for Amendment of Rules

OAR 690-522-0030 & -0050

Deschutes Basin Water Management Rules

Background

- Mitigation or offset required in DGWSA for new groundwater permits.
- 2. By rule, we have a 200 cfs cap on final orders and permits.
- 3. Temporary mitigation is cheaper than permanent mitigation.
- 4. In 2010, the Division 522 rules were adopted:
 - A. Cap Management
 - B. Re-Use of Permanent Mitigation Credits if water right cancelled
- 5. This is a simple rulemaking.



Need for Rule Change Simple but Technical

- When a permit or certificate that debited water from the 200 cfs cap is later cancelled, the 200 cfs cap should be credited with the amount cancelled.
- 2. Current rule limits the method of cancellation to select methods of cancellation.
- 3. The proposed amendments would allow water to be added back to the cap if water right is cancelled for any reason.
- 4. A similar problem exists for permanent mitigation credits. Proposed amendments would allow permanent credits to be re-assigned if water right is cancelled for any reason.

Need for Rule Change - continued

- Cancelled Permits Affected by Current Rules:
 - 7 Permits Cancelled as of 6/1/2015 (0.549 CFS)
 - 3 Voluntarily Cancelled
 - 4 Cancelled under ORS 537.260
 - 1 with 9.0 Permanent Mitigation Credits
- No certificates, issued under this program, have been cancelled to date.
