

OREGON'S INTEGRATED WATER RESOURCES STRATEGY










PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION – PRE-APPLICATION



PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION - REVIEW





Proposed rules describe provisions of the grant and loan program, including:

 - review, score, and rank projects;
 - provide for public process;
- Biennial review of program
