


















- Place-Based Planning Guidelines (February 2015)
- Senate Bill 266 passed (July 2015)
 - WRD "may issue grants [...] to facilitate the preparation of place-based integrated water resources strategies"
 - WRD "may adopt rules for the administration" of these grants
- \$750,000 to pilot place-based planning
- Two new staff positions
 - Temporary worker hired
- Proposed process & schedule developed for discussion

Selecting Pilots

- Flexible while still being structured, transparent and fair
- Competitive process using letter of interest as the grant application
 - Conduct follow-up interviews and collect supplemental information (as needed)
 - Connect with field staff and other partners
- Inter-agency review and recommendations
- Commission approves pilot selection at Feb/Mar meeting



Evaluation Criteria

- Consistent with IWRS objectives and place-based planning guidelines
- Capable convener
- Clear interest and need
- Willing partners
- Balanced representation of interests
- Capacity to develop a plan within 3 years

Communication & Outreach

- Meetings with core stakeholder groups to vet process and schedule before release
- Communication and outreach strategy currently under development
 - Review strategy internally and with agency partners to identify outreach opportunities
 - Outreach during late September and October
- Recommendations?

Financial & Technical Assistance

- \$750,000 available in 2017
- Pilot areas request funding amounts
- Number of grants/pilots vary depending on funding requests
- Grants will not exceed \$250,000
- Release funding in phases tied to planning milestones
- WRD technical assistance
 - Logistics support, facilitation, project management
 - Technical studies, monitoring, report development

Commission Involvement

- Today feedback on proposal
- Update at November Commission meeting
 - Letters of interest received
 - Modifications to process or schedule
- Solicit feedback from Commission members on proposals (ongoing)
- Provide recommendations for Commission approval at Feb/Mar meeting

Water Development Loan Fund

Discussion

- Funding source based on ability of applicant to repay
- Water Development projects for irrigation, drainage, fish protection, watershed restoration and municipal uses
- Interest rate is based on bond issuance rate plus amount for administration
- Umatilla project has expressed interest in a \$22 million loan
- Loan may occur as soon as early 2016


