
Creation of opportunities for partnerships and innovation

- + Money on the ground by spring



- Available Funding: \$2.8 million in grants








Cycle 2 - Interest to Date

Staff have responded to nearly two dozen inquiries:








WATER PROJECT GRANTS AND LOANS

- Available Funding: \$14 million for grants and loans






Staff have responded to 30 inquiries






Water Project Grants & Loans

- Umatilla expressed interest in borrowing \$22 million of the \$30 million available

- \$11 million authorized by the Legislature
- JR Cook to provide update on past and future of the project
