







NORTH FORK SMITH RIVER






WATERSHED IN OREGON

PETITION FOR WITHDRAWAL

- Delivered at September Commission
 Meeting
- Proposes to withdraw all surface and groundwater from appropriation
 - Except for instream
 - Including exempt uses

WITHDRAWAL STATUTE

- ORS 536.410 Commission can issue an order to withdraw
- Must hold a public hearing first
- Standard of review:
 - order is necessary to ensure compliance with the state water resources policy, or
 - in the public interest to conserve water resources for the maximum beneficial use and control

WITHDRAWAL STATUTE

- Order specifies:
 - the waters withdrawn
 - the uses for which the waters are withdrawn
 - the reasons for the withdrawal
 - the duration of the withdrawal

ISSUES POSED BY STATUTE

Order:

"any agency action expressed orally or in writing directed to a <u>named person or named persons</u>, other than employees, officers or members of an agency"

ISSUES POSED BY STATUTE

• Rule:

"agency directive, standard or statement of general applicability that implements, interprets or prescribes law or policy."

OTHER OPTIONS

- Scenic Waterway
- ODFW, OPRD, ODEQ apply for instream water rights
- Legislative withdrawal
- Basin program amendment to classify waters or reclassify waters

CONCLUSION

- Issuing withdrawal order legally problematic
- Do not pursue action under ORS 536.410
- If interested in pursuing, more properly done through a basin program amendment
 - Includes public process
 - Rules advisory committee
 - Notice in local newspapers
 - Hearing in the basin
 - Criteria and challenges with this approach needs further analysis

COMMISSION ACTION

The Commission may consider the following alternatives:

- 1. Take no action on the petition and direct the Department to evaluate other options and report back to the Commission.
- 2. Take no action on the petition and direct the Department to provide further information on the merits of the petition in order for the Commission to consider pursuing withdrawal under ORS 536.410.
- 3. Deny the petition and direct the Department to take no further action.

DIRECTOR'S RECOMMENDATION

The Director recommends Alternative 1.

- 1. Take no action on the petition and direct the Department to evaluate other options and report back to the Commission.
- 2. Take no action on the petition and direct the Department to provide further information on the merits of the petition in order for the Commission to consider pursuing withdrawal under ORS 536.410.
- 3. Deny the petition and direct the Department to take no further action.
