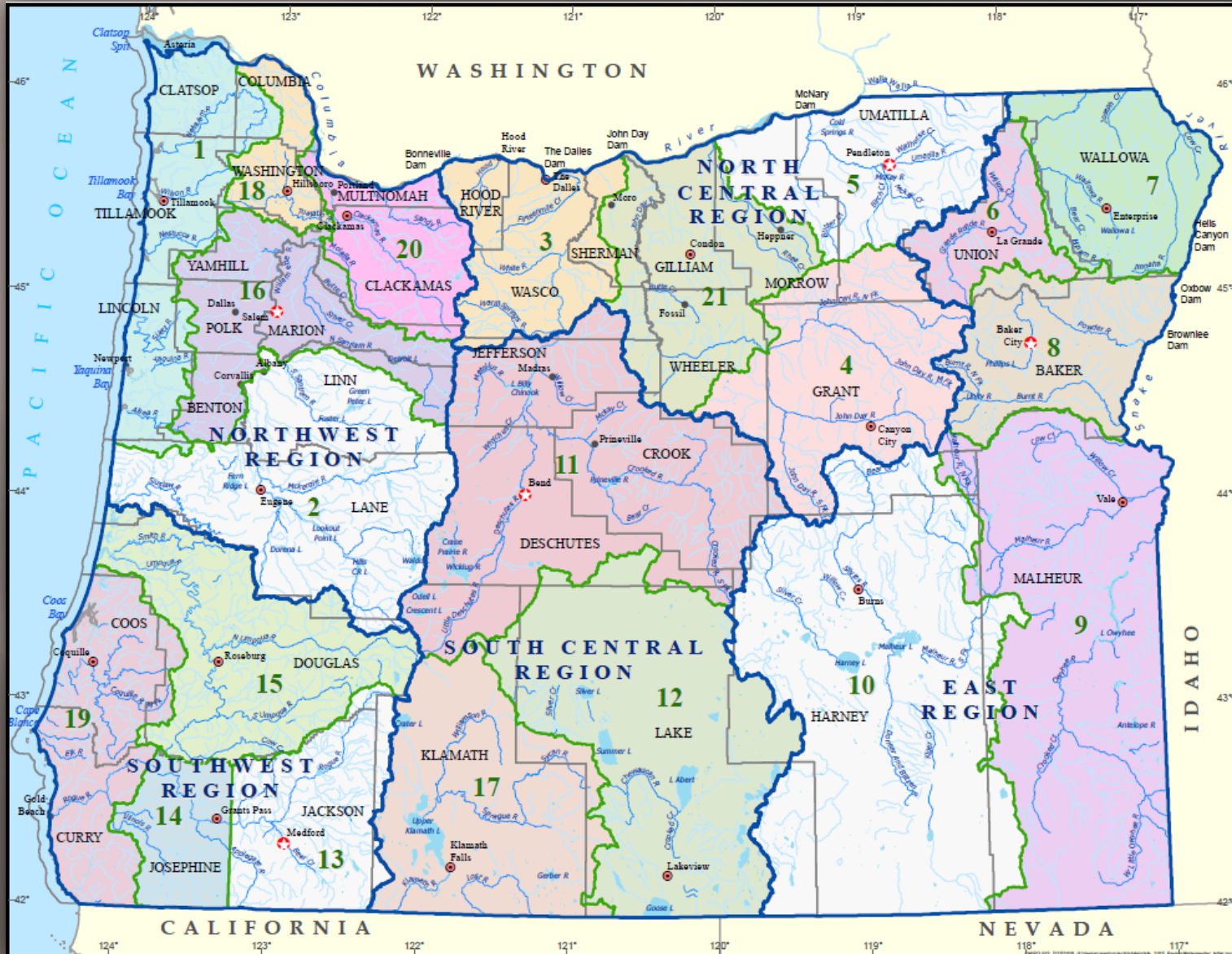

“Any action that causes a change in use or maintenance, or a field inspection that confirms that no change is needed to comply with the water right, statute, or order to the department”

NOTICE of REGULATION of WATER USE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the responsible party, that I have regulated and posted this WATER USE CONTROL on _____, 20____, at _____ hrs., and the same is under my control. This order is posted according to ORS 540.045 and is legal notice to anyone interested in the diversion or use of water from _____. You may not lawfully change or interfere with this water use control. A violation of this regulation is punishable by a fine and/or imprisonment. This order expires on _____ at _____ hrs., unless otherwise notified by the Watermaster.

REASON FOR REGULATION

- Use of water without a valid water right.
- Violation of permit condition.
- Violation of ORS 540.310 and 540.320 (headgate/measuring device).
- Water supply insufficient to satisfy senior rights.
- Other _____

This is a FINAL ORDER in other than a contested case, subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the time specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

OREGON WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

Effective immediately, your surface water right newer than February 19, 1963, is regulated off due to low stream flow. In-house domestic use, stock water, and supplemental supplies from reservoirs or wells are not affected by this regulation. If you have any questions, please contact our office.

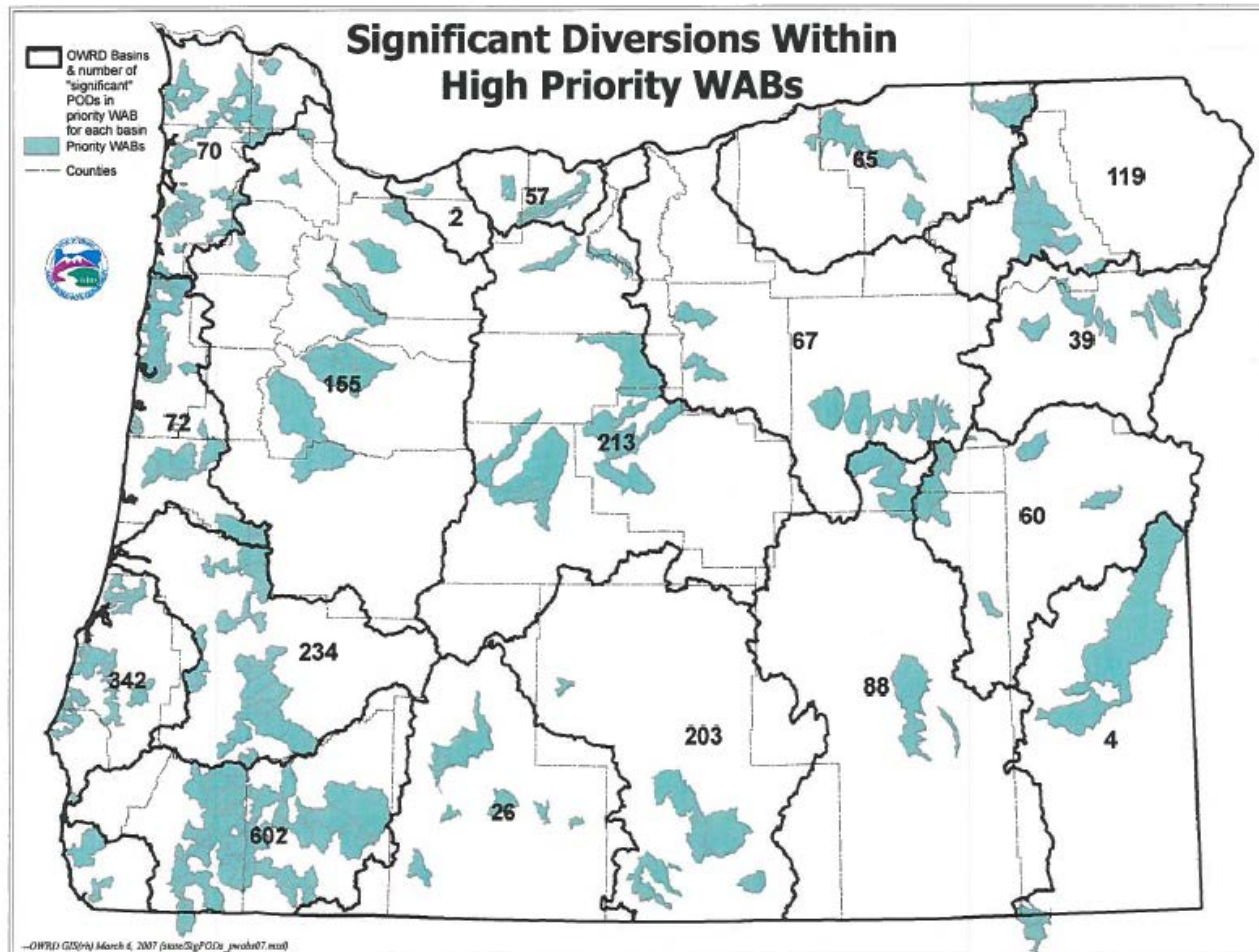


STRATEGIC MEASUREMENT STRATEGY

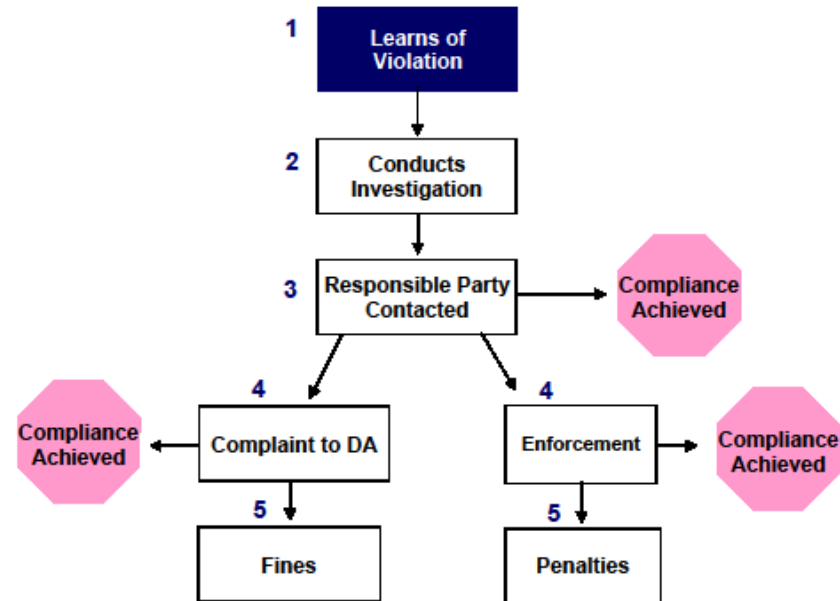
