RULEMAKING; ATTORNEY GENERAL'S MODEL RULES

Notice

690-01-000 Prior to the adoption, amendment, or repeal of any rule by the Water Resources Commission the Water Resources Department shall give notice of the proposed adoption, amendment, or repeal:

- (1) In the Secretary of State's Bulletin referred to in ORS 183.360 at least 21 days prior to the effective date.
- (2) By mailing a copy of the notice and a copy of the rule or an explanation of how the person or organization may acquire a copy of the rule to persons and organizations on the Water Resources Department's mailing list established pursuant to ORS 183.335(7) at least 28 days prior to the effective date.
 - (3) By mailing a copy of the notice to the following persons, organizations, or publications:
 - (a) State agency members of the Strategic Water Management Group (ORS 536.100);
 - (b) Associated Press;
 - (c) Persons and organizations filing a written request for such notice with the Department;
 - (d) Cities, counties, and local planning agencies likely to be directly affected by the proposed rule.
