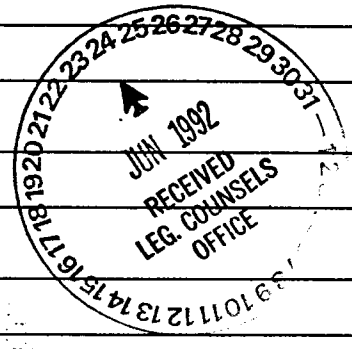

RULEMAKING; ATTORNEY GENERAL'S MODEL RULES

Notice

690-01-000 Prior to the adoption, amendment, or repeal of any permanent rule by the Water Resources Commission, the Water Resources Department shall give notice of the proposed adoption, amendment, or repeal:

- (1) In the Secretary of State's Bulletin referred to in ORS 183.360 at least fifteen (15) days prior to the effective date.
- (2) By mailing a copy of the notice to persons and organizations on the Water Resources Department's mailing list established pursuant to ORS 183.335(7) at least fifteen (15) days prior to the effective date.
- (3) By mailing a copy of the notice to the following persons, organizations, or publications:
 - (a) Stage agency members of the Strategic Water Management Group (ORS 536.100);
 - (b) United Press International and Associated Press;
 - (c) Persons and organizations filing a written request for such notice with the Department;
 - (d) Cities, counties, and local planning agencies likely to be directly affected by the proposed rule.

690-01-003 In the adoption, amendment or repeal of any permanent or temporary rule, the applicable procedures established in ORS 183.335 - 183.410 and OAR 137-01-005 - 137-01-085 shall be followed.

Model Rules of Procedure, Adoption

690-01-005 The Attorney General's Model and Uniform Rules of Procedure, November 4, 1991 edition, with the exception of OAR 137-03-090 to 137-03-092, were adopted by the Water Resources Commission on January 31, 1992, and shall be followed in all matters except where a different procedure is prescribed by statute or in OAR Chapter 690.
