STATUTORY AUTHORITY: ORS 536.027, 183.335

STATEMENT OF NEED: The Water Resources Commission needs the rules to respond to public requests for uses of water not currently included in basin programs. The proposed rules allow the department to accept applications for water uses in limited cases where there are unusual circumstances and no known adverse impacts. The rules provide for public notice and opportunity for filing of objections. Without the rules, the Commission's only option for responding to these public requests is to amend the basin program. This procedure may be inappropriate or unnecessarily time-consuming or expensive in circumstances such as a proposal to use water for a short-term, emergency use.

PRINCIPAL DOCUMENTS RELIED UPON: Water Resources Commission Staff Report of May 30, 1986; Minutes of the Water Resources Commission meeting of August 25, 1987.

These documents are available for inspection during regular business hours at the Water Resources Department, 3850 Portland, Road NE, Salem, OR 97310.

FISCAL AND ECONOMIC IMPACT: Administrative costs to the Water Resources Commission may be less than at present because the Commission may not have to hold a hearing upon a request unless requested. No negative economic impact is anticipated on small businesses. The rules require proposed uses to be consistent with acknowledged comprehensive plans.

RULES FOR ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS FOR WATER USES IN ADDITION TO CLASSIFIED USES

PURPOSE

690-82-010 These rules authorize the Director of the Water Resources Department to accept applications to appropriate water for a use in addition to the uses for which particular waters are classified in the applicable basin program. These rules apply in all basins for which the Water Resources Commission has adopted a basin program.

DEFINITIONS

690-82-020 The following definitions apply to OAR 690-82-010 to 690-82-080.

Basin Program: An administrative rule described in DAR 690-80-000, adopted by the Water Resources Commission under DRS Chapter 536.

Classified Uses: Beneficial uses of water designated in the basin programs for which water use applications may be accepted.

Commission: The Water Resources Commission.

Department: The Water Resources Department.

Director: The Director of the Water Resources Department.

APPLICATION FILING

690-82-030 An application for a permit to appropriate water under these rules must be accompanied by a letter to the Director showing:

- 1. The use will be of short duration during each year or for a continuous use period of no longer than five years; or
- 2. The use is of an unusual nature not likely to recur in the basin, and unlikely to have been within the uses considered by the Commission in adopting present basin classifications.

SPECIAL APPLICATION PROCESS

690-32-040 When the Department receives a completed application form and letter under 690-82-030, notice that the Director proposes to accept the application under these rules shall be provided to the Commission, appropriate state and federal agencies, affected city or county planning departments, appropriate Indian Tribes, others believed to have any interest in the proposed use and anyone requesting notice. The notice shall set the time and manner for filing objections to the proposed use. Objections shall be filed within 25 days of the date of agency mailing of the notice unless otherwise specified.

ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATION

690-82-050 The Director shall accept the application if after full consideration of all the comments and objections received within the prescribed period the Director concludes that:

- 1. Any valid objections to the proposed use could be fully satisfied by appropriate conditions on any permit or certificate issued; and
- 2. The proposed use is unlikely to create adverse impacts on other water uses; and
- 3. The proposed use is unlikely to adversely impact future appropriations for classified uses; and
- 4. The proposed use is consistent with acknowledged comprehensive plans and land use regulations; and
- 5. The source of water has not been withdrawn from further appropriation.

PRIORITY DATE

690-82-060 The date of priority for all applications received under OAR 690-82-040 shall be the date the application is accepted by the Director after review and approval of the proposed water use under 690-82-050.

NORMAL APPLICATION PROCESS

690-82-070 Any application accepted for filing under these rules shall be processed in the same manner as all other applications to appropriate water, as provided in OAR 690, Divisions 1 and 11.

RIGHT TO PETITION

690-82-080 No action taken under these rules shall affect an applicant's right to petition the Commission under the provisions of OAR 137-01-070 for a change in a basin program to allow specific water uses.
