The Oregon Water Resources Commission develops, adopts and periodically modifies programs for the state's major administrative basins as part of its statutory responsibility to progressively formulate an integrated, coordinated program for the use and control of the water resources of the state (ORS 536.300). Basin programs are administrative rules which establish water management policies and objectives and which govern new appropriations of the surface and groundwater within each of the respective basins. There is a need to revise the basin program rules to reflect changes in statute and other related administrative rules. The Department is proposing changes to the basin programs for the Rogue (Division 515), Umpqua (Division 516), South Coast (Division 517), Mid-Coast (Division 518) and North Coast (Division 501), which together comprise the coastal basin programs for the state.
