PUBLIC NOTICE OF WATER USE REQUESTS
March 13, 2018

This publication lists agency activities requiring public notice. It also describes public comment processes and deadlines. Types of water use requests in this week's Public Notice include:

- * **Permit Application Initial Reviews, Proposed Final Orders, and Final Orders**
Applications for permits to use, store, divert or pump surface water or groundwater. Includes applications by the state Departments of Fish & Wildlife, Environmental Quality or Parks and Recreation for water to be used and kept in-channel.
- * **Expedited Secondary Applications to Use Stored Water**
Applications to use stored water exclusively, filed under a simplified review process.
- * **Applications for Allocation Of Conserved Water**
Applications made by a water user who conserves water to use a portion of the conserved water on additional lands, lease or sell the water, or dedicate the water to instream use.
- * **Establishment of Mitigation Credits in the Deschutes Basin pursuant to OAR Chapter 690, Division 521 (ORS 537.746)**
- * **Applications for Extensions of Time to Perfect Water Right Permits**
New applications received and proposed final orders regarding requests to extend time limits to fully develop water use projects and beneficially apply water.
- * **Applications for Limited Licenses**
Requests to use water for 5 years or less. Licenses are subordinate to other rights and may be revoked if a use is found to injure other water right holders.
- * **Renewal of Aquifer Storage and Recovery (ASR) Limited Licenses**
Requests for use of water in an ASR testing program for 5 years or less. Licenses are subordinate to other rights if they are not based on use under an existing water right.
- * **Transfer Applications: Temporary Transfers**
Requests to temporarily change place of use and, if necessary to convey the water to the new place of use, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation.
- * **Transfer Applications: Regular**
Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, or character of use upon which the public may comment. The changes may be proposed in an application for a transfer (including instream or historic POD), an exchange, or a substitution.

- * **Transfer Applications: Permit Amendments**
Requests to amend permits.
- * **Water Management and Conservation Plan Progress Reports**
Water management and conservation plan progress reports submitted by municipalities under provisions of OAR Chapter 690, Division 86.
- * **Certificate Issuance**
Included in this section is a listing of recently issued water right certificates.
- * **Notice of Application to Split a Permit**
Request to assign all or part of a water right permit for irrigation, nursery, temperature control, stock watering, or agricultural water use and to issue replacement permit(s) to reflect an assignment from the current permit holder to one or more additional permit holders.

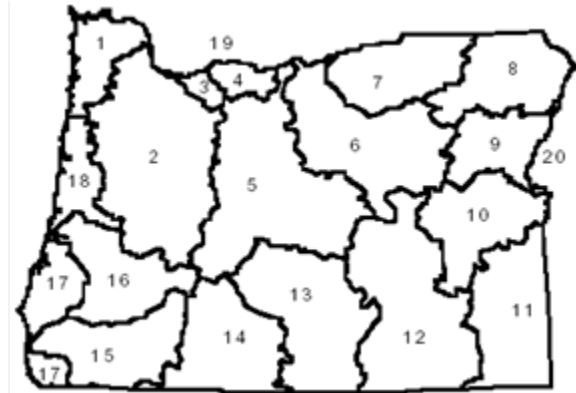

Initial Review and Proposed Final Orders

The following pages of this notice list permit applications that the Department is evaluating for compliance with state water law. Public participation and comment is encouraged. Opportunities for public involvement vary according to the stage of the permit evaluation.

Ground water permit applications in the Deschutes Basin (Basin 5) may seek to provide mitigation pursuant to the Deschutes Ground Water Mitigation Rules.

Initial Review Stage (IR)

The Department has given the applicant an initial review of water-use restrictions, water availability and other limitations that affect the agency's decision on whether to issue a permit. The Department welcomes comments from interested persons, agencies and organizations on the proposed water use.

The comment deadline for initial reviews appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Thursday, April 12, 2018. Although we cannot respond individually to all comments, each will be considered as the agency makes its decision regarding proposed allocations.

Proposed Final Order Stage (PFO)

The proposed final order is the Department's penultimate decision on the water use request. The PFO documents the agency's decision through specific findings, including review of comments received. If appropriate, it includes a draft permit specifying any conditions or restrictions on the use. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$25. (Any person paying \$25 to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued.) PFO's may be viewed free of charge online at: <http://apps.wrd.state.or.us/apps/wr/wrinfo/>. Those disagreeing with the Department's decision as expressed in the PFO have 45 days to file a protest.

The protest deadline for proposed final orders appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Friday, April 27, 2018.

The protest filing fee is \$350 for the applicants and \$700 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest are included in the PFO. Persons who support the PFO may file a "standing" fee of \$200 to retain the ability to participate in future proceedings relating to an application. Before participation in a hearing is allowed, an additional \$500 will be required to request to participate as a party or limited party.

If a protest or comment deadline falls on a day that the office is closed, then the next open business day automatically becomes the deadline date.

Applications for Allocation Of Conserved Water

The following applications for allocation of conserved water have been received pursuant to ORS 537.455 to 537.500 and OAR Chapter 690, Division 18. In reviewing the applications, the Department will consider whether the diversion for the uses allowed under the original water right will be reduced by the conservation project, whether existing water rights will be protected from injury, and whether the project is in compliance with local comprehensive land use plans.

Notice of Application for Allocation of Conserved Water **CW-102**

On February 12, 2018, North Unit Irrigation District (NUID), 2024 NW Beech Street, Madras, OR 97741, filed an application for Allocation of Conserved Water under ORS 537.470. Conserved water application CW-102 proposes to conserve approx. 2.04 CFS/610 AF under Certificate 72279 (priority 2/29/1913) from the Deschutes River and 0.32 CFS/137 AF under Certificate 90177 (9/18/1968 priority) from the Crooked River. This phase of the conservation project proposes to replace approx. 2.22 miles of unlined, earthen irrigation lateral 58-11 with buried HDPE pipeline. NUID proposes to protect 66% of the conserved water instream. The project appears to be consistent with the requirements under ORS 537.470.

Any party may provide written comments directly related to CW-102 within 20 days of the last date of newspaper publication, **03/15/2018**. Comments should be sent to ACW Program, Water Resources Department, 725 Summer Street NE, Suite A Salem, OR 97301-1266. Comments may be faxed to 503-986-0903. WRD will review all comments received when determining whether to approve the proposed ACW.

Establishment of Mitigation Credits in the Deschutes Basin

ORS 537.746 authorizes the Department to award mitigation credits in the Deschutes Basin to approved mitigation projects. Mitigation credits may be used in the Deschutes Basin, specifically the Deschutes Ground Water Study Area, to mitigate for the impacts of ground water use on surface water flows. Pursuant to OAR Chapter 690, Division 521, upon receipt of notification of a mitigation project, the Department shall give public notice of the intent to establish mitigation credits.

The public is invited to comment on establishment of mitigation credits for the project(s) described below. Comments must be received within 21 days of the date of this public notice. Comments should address the award of mitigation credits to the proposed project and its use for mitigation purposes. Included in this public notice is a preliminary determination as to the amount of mitigation credits that may be available from the proposed project.

Applications for Limited Licenses

A limited license allows the right to use or store water for no more than 5 consecutive years. Use of water under a limited license is subordinate to all other authorized uses and may be shut-off at any time to satisfy those other uses. In addition, the Department may revoke a limited license if its use causes injury to any other water right or minimum perennial streamflow.

Licensees must maintain a record of how much water they are using (ORS 537.143). **The Department may approve a license after March 27, 2018, upon finding that the proposed water use will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest (OAR 690-340-030).** The public is invited to provide comments that will assist the Director in determining whether the use would impair or be detrimental to the public interest. If the applicant applies for a use that is not one of the standard uses listed in OAR 690-300, the Department may, for the purposes of this notice, assign a named use that is reasonably close to the use actually requested. The public may examine the actual application by clicking the associated hyperlink and then choosing “LL Application” under “Scanned Documents.”

Renewal of Aquifer Storage and Recovery (ASR) Limited Licenses

ASR means the storage of water from a separate source that meets drinking water standards in a suitable aquifer for later recovery and not having as one of its primary purposes the restoration of the aquifer (ORS 537.531). The use of water for ASR testing purposes requires a limited license pursuant to ORS 537.534. The requirements and procedures of an ASR limited license are different than those for limited licenses pursuant to ORS 537.143. Only after completion of an ASR testing program under a limited license may an applicant apply for a permanent ASR permit. The appearance of a renewal request in the public notice commences a 30-day public comment period. Following the public comment period, the Department may request additional information regarding the renewal request, renew the limited license, renew the limited license with additional conditions, or deny the request.

An ASR Limited License may be renewed if the applicant demonstrates to the Director's satisfaction that further testing is necessary and that the applicant complied with the terms of the limited license. The standards, findings and process used in the license renewal process shall be as provided in OAR 690-350-0020. The Director may renew an ASR Limited License for a term of not more than 5 years.
