## 2018 Legislative Session Recap

# **WRD Budget Packages**

- Groundwater = \$1.29 million (\$2.39 million)
  - No funds provided
- Litigation = \$1.29 million
  - Budget for 2017-19 = \$835k avg. \$35k/month
  - •July-Jan. DOJ Billings = \$600k avg. \$86k/month
  - Challenge to address net hiring slowdown
  - No funds provided

- Water-Related Legislation Did not pass
  - HB 4016 Klamath Project Determined
     Claim Transfers
  - •SB 1528 Transfers of Stored Water

- January-April WRD meets with stakeholders\*
- April 13 Legislative Concepts (LC) to DAS
- •June 8 LC placeholder information to DAS\*
- September 30 (or 14 days after receipt of LC) –
   Request one revision\*
- December 7 File agency Legislative Concepts

## **2019 Budget Timelines**

- Deadlines not yet set
- Budget instructions issued in late March
- Typical schedule:
  - January-May Obtain feedback on proposals; conduct stakeholder meetings
  - May Lock numbers for budget packages
  - August 1 Final budget narrative due
