

Background

- ORS 536.750(1)(c) allows Commission to grant a preference for water for stock and human consumption
 - Only while Governor's drought declaration in effect
- Governor's Executive Order No. 18-02 issued on March 13, 2018
 - Declared drought emergency in Klamath County
 - In effect through December, unless rescinded



Background

- Commission adopted temporary preference rules,
 OAR 690-022
 - Stock watering in the Williamson River Basin
 - **≻13** registered
 - Human Consumption in Klamath County
 - >4 registered
 - Temporary rules 180 days



Requests for Extending

- Preference users want to use water past October
 - Temporary rules expire October 13
- Wood River Basin water right holders are also seeking to use the stock water preference
 - Currently not authorized to receive the preference in the temporary rules



Options for Extending

- OAR 690-022 has temporarily granted the preference in certain areas of Klamath County, notwithstanding OAR 690-019
 - Temporary rules cannot be extended; must undergo permanent rule process
- OAR 690-019-0070 identifies a process that may be used to grant the preference without rulemaking via an Order of the Commission



Discussion of OAR 690-019

OAR 690-019-0070

- Order issued by Commission to include:
 - Expiration date
 - Geographic area
 - Which water uses are temporarily inferior
 - Statement that there is an immediate threat to the health and welfare of the people of Oregon
 - Requirement that political subdivisions submit water conservation or curtailment plans



Delegation Authority

- •ORS 536.025
 - Authorizes the Commission to delegate to the Director the exercise of any power vested by law upon the Commission...
- •OAR 609-019
 - Currently only provides for the Commission to issue the preference orders
- The Commission may delegate to the Director the authority to issue orders of the Commission to grant a drought preference.



Commission Action

The Commission may consider the following alternatives:

- 1. Delegate to the Director, the authority to issue orders granting a preference for human consumption and stock water use under ORS 536.740(1)(c) and OAR 690-019-0070 in Klamath County through December 2018.
- 2. Deny the request to delegate the authority to the Director.
- 3. Request that staff return at a future meeting with other alternatives.
- > The Director recommends Alternative 1.
