

#### **Initial Review and Proposed Final Orders**

The following pages of this notice list permit applications that the Department is evaluating for compliance with state water law. Public participation and comment is encouraged. Opportunities for public involvement vary according to the stage of the permit evaluation. Ground water permit applications in the Deschutes Basin (Basin 5) may seek to provide mitigation pursuant to the Deschutes Ground Water Mitigation Rules.

#### **Initial Review Stage (IR)**

The Department has given the applicant an initial review of water-use restrictions, water availability and other limitations that affect the agency's decision on whether to issue a permit. The Department welcomes comments from interested persons, agencies and organizations on the proposed water use. **The comment deadline for initial reviews appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Thursday, June 27, 2019.** Although we cannot respond individually to all comments, each will be considered as the agency makes its decision regarding proposed allocations.

#### **Proposed Final Order Stage (PFO)**

The proposed final order is the Department's penultimate decision on the water use request. The PFO documents the agency's decision through specific findings, including review of comments received. If appropriate, it includes a draft permit specifying any conditions or restrictions on the use. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$25. (Any person paying \$25 to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued.) PFO's may be viewed free of charge online at: <a href="http://apps.wrd.state.or.us/apps/wr/wrinfo/">http://apps.wrd.state.or.us/apps/wr/wrinfo/</a>. Those disagreeing with the Department's decision as expressed in the PFO have 45 days to file a protest.

### The protest deadline for proposed final orders appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Friday, July 12, 2019.

The protest filing fee is \$410 for the applicants and \$810 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest are included in the PFO. Persons who support the PFO may file a "standing" fee of \$230 to retain the ability to participate in future proceedings relating to an application. Before participation in a hearing is allowed, an additional \$580 will be required to request to participate as a party or limited party.

If a protest or comment deadline falls on a day that the office is closed, then the next open business day automatically becomes the deadline date.

#### **Applications for Allocation Of Conserved Water**

The following applications for allocation of conserved water have been received pursuant to ORS 537.455 to 537.500 and OAR Chapter 690, Division 18. In reviewing the applications, the Department will consider whether the diversion for the uses allowed under the original water right will be reduced by the conservation project, whether existing water rights will be protected from injury, and whether the project is in compliance with local comprehensive land use plans.

#### Notice of Application for Allocation of Conserved Water CW-111 and Additional Point of Diversion

CW-111 filed by Ken & Bobbie Baker, 81705 Hwy 82, Wallowa, OR 97885, and Perry Johnston, 81703 Hwy 82, Wallowa, OR 97885, proposes to convert approx. 235.6 acres from flood irrigation to high efficiency pivot irrigation. The project on the Lostine (aka South Fork Wallowa) is expected to conserve approx. 1.98 cubic feet per second (CFS) and 353.4 acre-feet (AF) as follows:

Certificate 3153: 1883 Priority; Lostine River; conserving 0.63 CFS and 112.65 AF on 75.1 acres located in SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec. 29, and NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> and NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec. 32, T1N, R43E, W.M.

Certificate 94327: 1883 Priority; Lostine River; conserving 0.75 CFS and 134.55 AF on 89.7 acres located in NE¼ and SE¼ of Sec. 32, T1N, R43E, W.M.

Certificate 94163: 1882 Priority; Lostine River, conserving 0.59 CFS and 106.2 AF on 70.8 acres located in the SE¼ of Sec. 32, T1N, R43E, W.M. The applicants also propose the Foster Ditch as an additional point of diversion downstream approx. 1.2 miles from the Miles Ditch.

The Applicants propose 100% of the conserved water (353.4 AF) be allocated to the state for instream purposes. The Applicants propose to change the place of use for 3.3 acres of Cert. 3153 and 7.2 acres of Cert 94327 to accommodate the pivot irrigation.

The project appears to be consistent with the requirements under ORS 537.470. Any interested person may submit written comments for the applications. Comments must be received within 20 days of the last day of publication, **06/05/2019**. Comments should be sent to the attention of the ACW Program, Water Resources Department, 725 Summer Street NE, Suite A, Salem, OR 97301.

#### Notice of Application for Allocation of Conserved Water CW-112

On April 26, 2019, Dustin Jinks, 1061 Westside Road, Camas Valley, OR 97416, filed an application for Allocation of Conserved Water under ORS 537.470. Certificate 14664 is for 0.35 cubic feet per second (CFS) from Middle Fork of the Coquille River for irrigation of 27.8 acres with a priority date of 8/25/1939. The conservation project proposes to convert leaking aluminum piping with poly-pipe and replacing impact sprinklers with 2.0 gph drip emitters. The project proposes to conserve approx. 0.34 CFS. The applicant proposes to protect 25% (0.09 CFS) of the conserved water instream. Any party may provide written comments directly related to CW-112 within 20 days of the last date of newspaper publication, 6/4/2019. Comments should be sent to ACW Program, Water Resources Department, 725 Summer Street NE, Suite A, Salem, OR 97301-1266. WRD will review all comments received when determining whether to approve the proposed ACW.

## Proposed Final Orders Regarding Applications for Extensions of Time for Water Right Permits

ORS 537.230, 537.248, 537.630 and 539.010 authorize the Water Resources Department to extend time limits contained in water right permits for completing construction of water development projects and applying water to full beneficial use. Procedures for permit holders to apply for extensions and for the Department to evaluate and determine whether or not to approve extensions of time are contained in OAR 690-320-0010 for extensions filed before July 1, 2001, and in OAR 690-315-0010 for extensions filed on or after July 1, 2001.

Proposed Final Orders (PFO's) are the Department's preliminary decision on extension requests. They document the agency's decision through specific findings. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$25. (Any person paying to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued). PFO's may be viewed for free at the Department's Salem Office or at the appropriate watermaster district office.
