

Application History

- On February 21, 2013, EVWD applied for a permit to store 12,000 acre-feet of water from Drift Creek, near Silverton
- Water would be stored in a reservoir located on Drift Creek's channel and would be used for irrigation and flow augmentation





- On July 22, 2014, OWRD issued a Proposed Final Order recommending approval of the proposed use and imposing numerous conditions.
- Protests were received by the protest deadline.
- CCH held June 18-29, 2018
- ALJ issued Proposed Order and exceptions were filed.
- Director considering exceptions.



Process Going Forward

- 1. Director will issue Final Order.
- 2. 20-day period to file exceptions
- 3. Subcommittee will review exceptions, deliberate and make recommendation to full Commission.
- 4. Commission will consider recommendations and determine next steps.



Recommendation:

• Staff recommend that the Commission appoint a subcommittee to review the anticipated exceptions filed to the Director's Final Order and then make recommendation for action to the full Commission.
