A. Request for Adoption of Rules Relating to Groundwater-Use Regulation to Protect Senior Surface Water Rights in the Upper Klamath Basin (Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 690, Division 025)

Ivan Gall, Field Services Division Administrator presented on the Department's rulemaking process. The Department proposed to repeal the existing Division 025 rules and adopt new, interim rules that govern the regulation of groundwater in the Upper Klamath Basin. The rulemaking proposed to repeal OAR 690-025-0010 in response to the termination of the Upper Klamath Basin Comprehensive Agreement, and to adopt OAR 690-025-0020, -0025, and -0040 to establish procedures for the control of groundwater uses to protect senior surface water rights in the Upper Klamath Basin, in lieu of regulating water use under OAR 690-009. The proposed rules expire on March 1, 2021, by which time more comprehensive rules are expected to be adopted after engagement and outreach with the water-user community and stakeholders in the basin. Commissioner Faught moved to adopt the Division 025 rules, Commissioner Baumgartner seconded the motion. Voting in favor of the motion; Commissioners Baumgartner, Corn, Faught, Kihara, Moll, Quaempts, and Reeves. Motion passed.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
