This publication lists agency activities requiring public notice. It also describes public comment processes and deadlines. Types of water use requests in this week's Public Notice include:

* **Permit Application Initial Reviews, Proposed Final Orders, and Final Orders** Applications for permits to use, store, divert or pump surface water or groundwater. Includes applications by the state Departments of Fish & Wildlife, Environmental Quality or Parks and Recreation for water to be used and kept in-channel.

* Alternate Reservoir Applications (ORS 537.409)

Applications for storage permits for small ponds filed under a simplified review process.

- * Applications for Allocation Of Conserved Water Applications made by a water user who conserves water to use a portion of the conserved water on additional lands, lease or sell the water, or dedicate the water to instream use.
- * Applications for Limited Licenses

Requests to use water for 5 years or less. Licenses are subordinate to other rights and may be revoked if a use is found to injure other water right holders.

* Application for Instream Lease

Application by water right holder to lease existing water rights to instream use.

* Transfer Applications: Regular

Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, or character of use upon which the public may comment. The changes may be proposed in an application for a transfer (including instream or historic POD), an exchange, or a substitution.

* Transfer Preliminary Determinations

Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, and character of use upon which the public may protest the application and Department's preliminary determination.

- * **Transfer Applications: Temporary Transfers** Requests to temporarily change place of use and, if necessary to convey the water to the new place of use, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation.
- * **Transfer Applications: Permit Amendments** Requests to amend permits.

* **Transfer Notice: District Permanent Transfers for Place of Use- ORS 540.580(4)** District notices filed for place of use changes within a district's boundary.

* Certificate Issuance

Included in this section is a listing of recently issued water right certificates.



Initial Review and Proposed Final Orders

The following pages of this notice list permit applications that the Department is evaluating for compliance with state water law. Public participation and comment is encouraged. Opportunities for public involvement vary according to the stage of the permit evaluation. Ground water permit applications in the Deschutes Basin (Basin 5) may seek to provide mitigation pursuant to the Deschutes Ground Water Mitigation Rules.

Initial Review Stage (IR)

The Department has given the applicant an initial review of water-use restrictions, water availability and other limitations that affect the agency's decision on whether to issue a permit. The Department welcomes comments from interested persons, agencies and organizations on the proposed water use. **The comment deadline for initial reviews appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Thursday, October 24, 2019.** Although we cannot respond individually to all comments, each will be considered as the agency makes its decision regarding proposed allocations.

Proposed Final Order Stage (PFO)

The proposed final order is the Department's penultimate decision on the water use request. The PFO documents the agency's decision through specific findings, including review of comments received. If appropriate, it includes a draft permit specifying any conditions or restrictions on the use. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$30. (Any person paying \$30 to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued.) PFO's may be viewed free of charge online at: <u>http://apps.wrd.state.or.us/apps/wr/wrinfo/</u>. Those disagreeing with the Department's decision as expressed in the PFO have 45 days to file a protest.

The protest deadline for proposed final orders appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Friday, November 08, 2019.

The protest filing fee is \$410 for the applicants and \$810 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest are included in the PFO. Persons who support the PFO may file a "standing" fee of \$230 to retain the ability to participate in future proceedings relating to an application. Before participation in a hearing is allowed, an additional \$580 will be required to request to participate as a party or limited party.

If a protest or comment deadline falls on a day that the office is closed, then the next open business day automatically becomes the deadline date.

Alternate Reservoir Applications (ORS 537.409)

For alternate reservoir applications filed under ORS 537.409, the public is invited to comment within 60 days of this notice. The law provides that within 60 days after the Department provides public notice of the application, any person may submit detailed, legally obtained information in writing, requesting the Department to deny the application for a permit on the basis that the reservoir:

- (A) Would result in injury to an existing water right; or
- (B) Would pose a significant detrimental impact to existing fishery resources as determined on the basis of information submitted by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife.

Such comments must be submitted on or before November 23, 2019.

Applications for Allocation Of Conserved Water

The following applications for allocation of conserved water have been received pursuant to ORS 537.455 to 537.500 and OAR Chapter 690, Division 18. In reviewing the applications, the Department will consider whether the diversion for the uses allowed under the original water right will be reduced by the conservation project, whether existing water rights will be protected from injury, and whether the project is in compliance with local comprehensive land use plans.

Notice of Application for Allocation of Conserved Water CW-113

On August 19, 2019, Dee Irrigation District, 4835 O'Leary Road, Hood River, OR 97031, submitted an application for an Allocation of Conserved Water under ORS 537.470. Certificate 86804 is for 12.5 cubic feet per second (CFS) from Camp Creek, with any deficiency in the available supply to be made up by diversion for No Name Creek and the West Fork Hood River, as follows: 12.5 CFS for Frost Protection of 102.0, 1.66 CFS for Irrigation of 132.7 acres, 1.0 CFS, for Spraying and 0.5 CFS for Stock Use, with a priority date of 2/10/1978. The conservation project proposes to convert from old leaky piping with open water boxes to new enclosed pressurized piping. The project proposes to conserve approx. 0.5 CFS. The applicant proposes to protect 100% (0.5 CFS) of the conserved water instream. Any party may provide written comments directly related to CW-113 within 20 days of the last day publication of this notice in the newspaper, **9/28/2019**. Comments should be sent to ACW Program, Water Resources Department, 725 Summer Street NE, Suite A, Salem, OR 97301-1266. WRD will review all comments received when determining whether to approve the proposed conservation project.

Applications for Limited Licenses

A limited license allows the right to use or store water for no more than 5 consecutive years. Use of water under a limited license is subordinate to all other authorized uses and may be shut-off at any time to satisfy those other uses. In addition, the Department may revoke a limited license if its use causes injury to any other water right or minimum perennial streamflow.

Licensees must maintain a record of how much water they are using (ORS 537.143). **The Department** may approve a license after October 08, 2019, upon finding that the proposed water use will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest (OAR 690-340-030). The public is invited to provide comments that will assist the Director in determining whether the use would impair or be detrimental to the public for a use that is not one of the standard uses listed in OAR 690-300, the Department may, for the purposes of this notice, assign a named use that is reasonably close to the use actually requested. The public may examine the actual application by clicking the associated hyperlink and then choosing "LL Application" under "Scanned Documents."

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Applications for Instream Lease

ORS 537.348 authorizes a water right holder to lease their existing water right(s) to instream use for a limited time. For the term of the lease, the water right holder agrees to suspend use of water under the original right. The state is the trustee for water rights leased for instream use. OAR 690-077-0077 requires that the Department public notice the lease applications.

The deadline for submitting claims of injury to existing water rights or enlargement of the original right against a lease application is October 15, 2019. Parties to the lease, including the Department, will review any such claims before the lease is finalized. Transfer Preliminary Determinations

A Preliminary Determination provides the Department's conclusion as to whether a proposed change in place of use, point of diversion or appropriation, or character of use of an existing water right should be approved. Changes of water rights may be proposed in an application for transfer (including instream, historic POD, exchange, substitution or ground water registration modification).

The Department has issued preliminary determinations on the transfer applications listed below. In addition to this notice, the Department is complying with ORS 540.520(2) that requires publication of notice in a local newspaper for all transfers except those proposing a change in place of use only or a change in point of diversion of less than ¹/₄ mile where there are no intervening diversion points.

Any person may protest the application and preliminary determination or may file a standing statement. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030(3) and OAR 690-382-0900, protests must raise all reasonably ascertainable issues and include all reasonably available arguments supporting the person's position. In addition, protests must be accompanied by a \$810 protest fee for non-applicant and \$410.00 protest fee for applicant. Call (503) 986-0815 to obtain additional information. Protests must be received by the Department on or before October 24, 2019, or within 30 days of the last date of publication in a newspaper, whichever is later. If no protests are filed, the Department will issue a final order consistent with the preliminary determination.

<u>T-12944</u> filed by Margaret and Thomas Barnett, 12814 Arndt RD NE, Aurora, OR 97002, proposes an additional point of appropriation and a change in place of use under Certificate 36301. The right allows the use of 0.01 cubic foot per second from one well in Sec. 4, T4S, R1W, WM for irrigation in Sec. 4. The applicant proposes an additional point of appropriation in Sec. 3, T4S, R1W, WM and to change the place of use to Sec. 3, T4S, R1W, WM. The Water Resources Department proposes to approve the transfer, based on the requirements of ORS Chapter 540 and OAR 690-380-5000.

<u>T-12765</u> filed by Seal Rock Water District, 1037 NW Grebe Street, Seal Rock, OR, 97376, proposes changes in place of use and character of use under Certificates 21390 and 32199. Certificate 21390 allows the use of 1.0 cubic foot per second from Henderson Creek in Sec. 30, T11S, R11W, WM for irrigation in Sec. 30. Certificate 32199 allows the use of 0.4 cubic foot per second from Hill Creek (aka Deer Creek) in Sec. 24, T12S, R12W, WM for irrigation in Sects. 18, 19, 30, and 31, T12S, R11W, WM, Sects. 24, 25 and 36, T12S, R12W, WM, Sects. 6, 7 and 18, T13S, R11W, WM and Sec. 1, T13S, R12W, WM. The applicant proposes to create time-limited instream uses in Henderson and Hill Creeks from the points of diversion to the mouth of the Creeks. The Water Resources Department proposes to approve the transfer, based on the requirements of ORS Chapter 540, OAR 690-380-5000 and OAR 690-077-0075.

<u>T-12833</u> filed by Golden Rule Farms Inc., PO Box 255, Christmas Valley, OR 97641, proposes changes in points of appropriation and place of use under Certificate 93424. The right allows the use of 3.03 cubic feet per second from Well 6, Well 7, Well 13 and Well 18 in Sects. 32 and 33, T25S, R31E, WM, for irrigation in Sects. 29 and 32, T25S, R31E, WM. The applicant proposes to move the points of appropriation to within Sec. 34, T26S, R32E, WM and to change the place of use to within Sec. 34, T26S, R32E, WM. The Water Resources Department proposes to approve the transfer, based on the requirements of ORS Chapter 540 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Transfer Applications: Temporary Transfer

The holder of a water right subject to transfer may request to temporarily change the place of use of the water for up to 5 years and, if necessary to convey the water, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation. The Department shall approve the request provided it does not cause injury to existing water rights or enlarge the water use. If after the change is approved, it is found to cause injury, the approved change may be revoked. The use of water reverts to the authorized place of use upon expiration of the temporary change.
