<u>Written Comments:</u> To ensure full consideration by the Commission, written comments must be emailed by 5:00 PM on Wednesday, April 29 to nirvana.cook@oregon.gov. A confirmation email will be sent. If you do not receive a confirmation email, please call Nirvana Cook at 503-986-0876. Note that the Commission cannot accept comments on items with an (*), as the public comment period for those items has closed.

Early delivery of written comments is strongly encouraged so that Commissioners have sufficient opportunity to review materials prior to the meeting.

<u>Oral Comments</u>: Comments relating to a specific agenda item will be heard by the Commission as each agenda item is considered. Comments on other topics may be made during the public comment period. If you wish to make public comment, press 5* on your telephone keypad, and this will signal the meeting host that you wish to address the Commission.
